21	obtained through a broker who is paid a commission by the insurance company and not the city;

23	WHEREAS, market forces that typically apply during a competitive procurement process		
24	are further restricted because the City participates in the Florida Municipal Insurance Trust Fund,		
25	which is administered by the Florida League of Cities and limited only to municipalities, to insure		
26	its physical facilities; and

28	WHEREAS, this trust fund provides property insurance for all City facilities; and		
29 30	WHEREAS, the property insurance for all City facilities provided by this trust fund		
31	represents the cost to replace damaged property with property of like kind and quality; and		
32	represente the sect to replace damaged property with property of into third and quality, and		
33	WHEREAS, the City Administration is recommending that the City renew its current		
34	property insurance with Florida Municipal Trust Fund for the total sum of Four Hundred Fifty Six		
35	Thousand Six Hundred Sixteen (\$456,616.00) Dollars for fiscal year 2018-2019; and		
36 37	WHEREAS, the City believes it is in the best interest of the City to renew the City's current
