2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11 12 13 14 15 16 17 18	A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT THE GRANT APPLICATION FOR THE 43RD YEAR CDBG PUBLIC WORKS IMPROVEMENT BLOCK GRANT PROJECT FOR THE FRIENDS OF THE HEPBURN CENTER AFTER SCHOOL TUTORIAL PROGRAM AND PUBLIC WORKS IMPROVEMENTS IN THE NW QUADRANT (DRAINAGE, SIDEWALKS, REGRADING/SODDING OF SWALES AND OTHER RELATED INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS) FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED EIGHT THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED (\$208,200.00) DOLLARS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL RELATED DOCUMENTS TO EFFECTUATE THE SUBMITTAL OF THE GRANT APPLICATION, AND ESTABLISH ACCOUNTS, AND FUNDING TO THE GRANT PROJECTS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
19 20	WHEREAS, the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program, run by
21	the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, is a flexible program that
22	provides communities with resources to address a wide range of community
23	development needs; and
24	WHEREAS, cities participating in the Broward County CDBG program receive an
25	allocation based on a Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) funding
26	formula; and
27	WHEREAS, the formula takes into consideration community housing conditions
28	population and poverty indicators; and
29	WHEREAS, the funding allocation is automatic and non-competitive, as long as
30	the allocation is for HUD/CDBG eligible activities, including capital, economic
31	development, and housing and public service projects, and
32	WHEREAS, the City plans to pursue two (2) projects during this CDBG funding
33	cycle. During a public meeting, residents were advised of the City's plan to continue the
34	After School Tutorial Program at the Hepburn Center under the first application and
35	implement infrastructure upgrades under the second application; and
36	WHEREAS, due to the fact that this year's funding allocation has not been
37	released, the Broward Housing and Community Development Division recommended
38	that both projects apply for the same or similar amount of funding as was awarded
39	during the 42 <sup>nd</sup> year cycle; and

40	WHEREAS, the City Administration will be requesting a similar amount during
41	the 43 <sup>rd</sup> year cycle: one hundred thousand (\$100,000.00) dollars for the After School
42	Tutorial Program and one hundred eight thousand two hundred (\$108,200.00) dollars for
43	the Public Works Improvement Projects.
44	NOW THEREFORE BE IT RECOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY
45	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY
46	COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:
47 48	<b>SECTION 1.</b> The above clauses are incorporated in full in this Resolution.

50	SECTION 2. City Manager's Authorization. The Mayor and City Commission
51	hereby authorize the City Manager to submit the grant application for the 43 <sup>rd</sup> Year
52	CDBG Public Works Improvement Block Grant Project for the Friends of the Hepburn
53	Center After School Tutorial Program and Public Works Improvements in the NW
54	Quadrant (drainage, sidewalks, regrading/sodding of swales and other related infrastrure
55	improvements) for a total amount not to exceed two hundred eight thousand two
56	hundred (\$208,200.00) dollars.
57	
58	SECTION 3. The City Manager is authorized to establish accounts and
59	implement funding for the grant projects. Further, the City Manager is authorized to
60	execute all funding agreements with Broward County and appropriate funding allocation
61	documents following approval.

63	<b>SECTION 4. Effective Date.</b> This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon
64	its passage and adoption.
