12	WILEDEAC the Chabber Committee coales to seed on arriving areas on City
L3	WHEREAS, the Shabbos Committee seeks to erect an eruv in areas on City
L4 	Property and Rights of Ways, as depicted in Exhibit A, in the North City Beach Park and
L5	South City Beach Park in Hallandale Beach ("Eruv Project"); and

L7	WHEREAS, the eruv demarcates a symbolic area wherein people of the Jewish
L8	faith are permitted to carry objects, push strollers and use canes and wheelchairs on the
L9	Sabbath and holidays, which are activities that are ordinarily prohibited outdoors in the
20	absence of an eruv; and
21	
22	WHEREAS, the eruv is a reasonable accommodation allowing Jewish members
23	of the community to access public parks in same manner as other residents and visitors
24	of the City and has no obvious religious display or symbolism to the general public; and
25	
26	WHEREAS, the Shabbos Committee has represented to the City that the area they
27	seek to encompass within the newly erected eruv represents an approximate area
28	previously encompassed within a longstanding eruv that was removed when utility
29	improvements were made in the area; and
30	
31	WHEREAS, the eruv system is comprised of a series of poles, string, hedges, and
32	other connections requiring monitoring and maintenance to ensure that all applicable
33	standards are met. The eruv system will be monitored on a weekly basis for compliance
34	and maintenance purposes by the Shabbos Committee; and

35	WHEREAS, the Shabbos Committee has agreed to amend their proposed project		
36	to better disguise the structure within the natural beach environment and to donate palr		
37	trees as necessary to disguise each post required for the eruv; and		
38			
39	WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission find that the proposed eruv is a		
40	reasonable accommodation to benefit residents of the City and is to be paid and		
41	maintained solely by the applicant.		
42			
43	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY		
44	COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

46	SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are confirmed as true and		
47	incorporated herein.		
48			
49	SECTION 2. City Commission Approval of Proposed Eruv Application. The		
50	Mayor and City Commission hereby approve the agreement for the construction and		
51	maintenance of the proposed eruv at North Beach and South Beach Parks.		
52			
53	SECTION 3. City Manager Authority. The City Manager is authorized to		
54	execute the agreement attached as Exhibit B. The City Manager is further authorized to		
55	approve minor modifications to the proposed eruv project to address current and future		
56	site conditions.

58	SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon		
59	its passage and adoption.
