Hallandale Beach Eruv Proposal

The Applicant

The applicant, **Shabbos Committed of the Beaches, LLC** is a Florida Limited Liability Company registered in the State of Florida since August, 2017.

Shabbos Committee of the Beaches, LLC, composed of volunteers, has been commissioned to oversee the project from inception to construction, including inspection during construction and maintenance once the Eruv is built. The proposed Eruv will service Jewish residents of Hallandale Beach as well as Jewish visitors to the area.

History

- October, 2017 Shabbos Committee of the Beaches, LLC proposed Eruv, on site meeting with City staff to discuss placement options
- November, 2017 Eruv Proposal/ Plan submitted to City (updated Dec., 2017)
 - January, 2018 Eruv Proposal on City Commission Agenda, applicant withdrew
- February, 2018 Eruv Proposal on City Commission Agenda, applicant withdrew
- March, 2018 Unauthorized Construction of Eruv at South City Beach Park
- March August, 2018 City staff worked with applicant for compliance and to discuss requirements and consider options, on site meeting held
 - September, 2018 Revised Eruv Proposal/ Plan submitted to City
 - October, 2018 City staff met with Shabbos Committee to discuss revised plan
 - November, 2018 Final Eruv Proposal/ Plan submitted to City





Hallandale Beach Eruv Proposal Current Proposal

South City Beach Park:

Install Fiberglass Pole at Four (4) Existing Palm Trees Install One (1) Additional Palm Tree with Fiberglass Pole

North City Beach Park:


Install Fiberglass Pole at Two (2) Existing Palm Trees Install Two (2) Additional Palm Tree with Fiberglass Pole

Poles connected to trees via approved clamps. Eruv string connection made at top of poles. Maximum three hundred (300) feet between poles. Fifteen (15) foot minimum clearance at all pedestrian and/or vehicular access points.


Installation Example – PVC Pipe at Existing/ New Palm Tree




North City Beach Park – Proposal/ Plan




North City Beach Park

Recap:

Eruv will be installed in an unobtrusive manner, as approved by the City, that will not damage or interfere with existing vegetation.

No temporary structures will be allowed.

All work will be performed by a licensed and insured contractor and will be inspected weekly by the organization.

The full cost of installation, inspections, and maintenance will be funded by the organization

A Certificate of Insurance will be provided to the City.

A construction and maintenance agreement will be executed.
