15	WHEREAS, on October 11, 2011, the Board of County Commissioners of Broward
16	County, Florida adopted Ordinance No. 2011-19 (the "Code of Ethics"), which implemented a
17	Code of Ethics for elected municipal officials; and
18	WHEREAS, the Code of Ethics establishes certain conditions and disclosure obligations
19	on elected officials who engage in fundraising on behalf of charitable organizations; and
20	WHEREAS, Section 1-19(C)(5)(A)(4) of the Code of Ethics provides that the additional
21	obligations shall not apply to an elected official who raises funds for those charities and events
22	which are formally approved by elected official's municipality; and
23	WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission of the City of Hallandale Beach desire to
24	designate the charities and organizations listed in Exhibit "A," as amended, a copy of which is
25	attached hereto and incorporated herein, as formally approved by the City of Hallandale Beach,
26	and therefore exempted from the charitable fundraising disclosure reporting provisions.
27	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF
28	HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:
29	SECTION 1. Resolution 2018-83 is hereby superseded.
30	SECTION 2. The Mayor and City Commission designate the charities and organizations
31	listed in Exhibit "A." as amended, hereto incorporated, as formally exempted from the fundraising

32	disclosure provisions of The Broward County Ethics Code Section 1-19(C)(5)(A)(4).
33	SECTION 3. Restrictions. Inclusion as an approved Charity or Event shall not impose
34	any duty or liability upon the City, and shall not serve as the basis for any claim by any person
35	against the City.
36	SECTION 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its
37	passage and adoption.
