17	all purchases of and contracts for equipment, supplies and contractual services, when the			
18	estimated cost shall exceed \$50,000 shall be based on competitive bids. Furthermore,			
19	pursuant to Chapter 23, Section 23-6, Award of Contract, the City Manager, shall have the			
20	authority to recommend to the City Commission award of contracts; and

22	WHEREAS, on August 17, 2016, the City Commission authorized the former City			
23	Manager to issue a work authorization to Synalovski Romanik Saye, LLC,			
24	(Architect/Engineer) to design, permit and produce construction plans and specifications			
25	for the Ingalls Park General Obligation Bond Project via Resolution #2016-117; and			
26				
27	WHEREAS, on November 9, 2017, the City released Bid # FY 2017-2018-003,			
28	Ingalls Park Construction for qualified general contracting firms to provide construction			
29	services utilizing the specifications, drawings and plans for Ingalls Park, located in the			
30	Southwest Quadrant at 735 SW 1st Street, Hallandale Beach, FL 33009. This project will			
31	be funded through the Parks General Obligation Bond approved by voters in November			
32	of 2014; and

34	WHEREAS, on November 16, 2017, a Mandatory Pre-Bid Conference was held at			
35	11:00 AM and eleven (11) vendors were in attendance; and			
36	WHEREAS, five (5) bids were received from K2 Builders, Epic Construction			
37	Solutions, LLC, E.L.C.I Construction Group, Inc., Alexander & Johnson Project			
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38	Management and Development, Inc., and West Construction, Inc However, all but West		
39	Construction were disqualified as either non-responsive or not responsible pursuant to the		
40	City's Procurement Code; and

42	WHEREAS, West Construction, Inc. was the lowest responsible and responsive		
43	bid at two million nine hundred seventy-one thousand five hundred and thirty seven dollars		
44	(\$2,971,537); and		
45			
46	WHEREAS, the City Administration recommends that the City Commission award		
47	Bid # FY 2017-2018-003, Ingalls Park Construction to the lowest responsive responsible		
48	bidder, West Construction, Inc. in an amount not to exceed two million nine hundred		
19	seventy-one thousand five hundred and thirty seven dollars (\$2,971,537), and to authorize		
50	the City Manager to negotiate and execute an agreement to effectuate the project; and

52	WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission have determined that the City		
53	Administration's recommendations are in the best interest of the City and its residents.
