L3 L4	WHEREAS, the City of Hallandale Beach has followed a Master Plan for the development		
L5	of a comprehensive world class parks system and obtained a General Obligation Bond (GO Bond)		
L6	to fund the development; and		
L7	to fulfid the development, and		
L7 L8	WHEREAS, for Ingalls Park, B&A Parks Master Plan report estimated the cost of		
19	redevelopment at \$300,000. This estimate increased to \$1,600,000 once staff developed the		
20	Opinion of Probable Cost in 2014 in preparation for the issuance of the GO Bond; and		
21			
22	WHEREAS, on November 9, 2017, the City released Bid # FY 2017-2018-003, Ingalls		
23	Park Construction, for qualified general contracting firms to provide construction services utilizing		
24	the specification, drawings and plans for Ingalls Park, located in the Southwest Quadrant at 735		
25	SW 1 st Street; and		
26			
27	WHEREAS, on January 31, 2018, the City Commission adopted Resolution #2018-006		
28	awarding Bid # FY2017-2018-003 and authorizing the City Manager to negotiate and execute an		
29	agreement with West Construction, Inc.; and		
30			
31	WHEREAS, during the awarding of the bid to West Construction, a Value Engineering		
32	Task was conducted to reduce construction costs; and		
33			
34	WHEREAS, the Value Engineering Task demonstrated that the Park's playground and		
35	fitness equipment and corresponding amenities were inadequate, and did not meet the original		
36	plans approved by the community. In addition, the irrigation system needed to be redesigned to		
37	be suitable for use. The Value Engineering Task also demonstrated that additional funding would		

38	be needed for picnic tables, surveillance cameras, and miscellaneous repairs, replacements,			
39	permits, and police detail; and

41	WHEREAS, City Administration is recommending the transfer and use of up to five			
42	hundred twenty nine thousand six hundred fifty three dollars (\$529,653) from the GO Bond			
43	Working Reserves Account to cover the additional costs as detailed above related to Ingalls Park			
44	construction; and			
45				
46	WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission have determined that the recommended			
47	budget transfer is in the best interest of the City and its residents and in compliance with the			
48	planned development of the Parks Master Plan.

50	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION			
51	OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

53	SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are incorporated herein.

55	SECTION 2. Approval of Budget Transfer. The Mayor and City Commission hereby			
56	authorize the City Manager to transfer the sum not to exceed five hundred twenty nine thousand			
57	six hundred fifty three dollars (\$529,653) from the GO Bond Working Reserves Account to cover			
58	additional costs related to Ingalls Park construction as part of the Parks Master Plan.

60	SECTION 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its			
61	passage and adoption.
