16	transportation solutions, cost estimates, funding strategies, and to create an implementation plan		
17	to help guide the City's capital transportation investments over the next twenty (20) years; and

19	WHEREAS, as a result, the Hallandale Beach Mobility Roadmap (Exhibit 1) has been		
20	developed; and

22	WHEREAS, the Hallandale Beach Mobility Roadmap includes an assessment of the
