2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11 12 13 14	A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CHANGE ORDER PURSUANT TO SECTION 23-12 OF THE HALLANDALE BEACH CODE OF ORDINANCES TO UNITED STATES SERVICES INDUSTRIES IN A TOTAL AMOUNT OVER THE THREE (3) YEAR TERM NOT TO EXCEED SEVENTY THREE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED SEVENTY ONE DOLLARS (\$73,971) FOR CUSTODIAL SERVICES AT ADDITIONAL LOCATIONS WITHIN THE CITY PUBLIC WORKS COMPLEX; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
15	WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 23-12 of the City Code of Ordinances, change orders by
16	more than either ten percent of the contract cost or in excess of \$50,000 require the approval of
17	the City Commission. The scope of any project may not be changed without prior approval of the
18	City Commission; and
19	WHEREAS, on June 6, 2018 the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 2018-045
20	awarding Bid # FY 2017-2018-009 to United States Services Industries (USSI). The scope of
21	services for this contract includes daily custodial services for the following city facilities: 1) City
22	Hall, 2) Police Department, 3) Commission Chambers, 4) Satellite Office at City Hall, 5) Main
23	Fire Station, 6) OB Johnson Park, 7) Foster Park, and 8) the Water Treatment Plant; and
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25	WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2018-045 awarded Bid # FY 2017-2018-009 to USSI in an
26	amount not to exceed one hundred seventy seven thousand two hundred seventy-one dollars
27	(\$177,271) per year for a term of three years for custodial services plus an additional amount not
28	to exceed fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) annually for as needed day porter services; and
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30	WHEREAS, the Public Works Complex includes the following buildings: Water Treatment
31	Plant, Public Works Office (including the Fleet Facility), Old Water Treatment Plant (including the
32	Sanitation Office), and the Auxiliary Building (including Crews Quarters, Supervisor's Office and
33	Lunch Room); and
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35	WHEREAS, within the Public Works Complex, only the Water Treatment Plant receives
36	custodial services under the USSI contract. The other buildings are serviced by the Public Works
37	Department's Custodial Division. This division currently has one part-time vacancy that will not be

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filled due to the hiring freeze in the General Fund; and

39 40 WHEREAS, in order to provide adequate custodial services to the Public Works Complex and not incur additional overtime cost in the Custodial Division, a change order to the USSI 41 42 Contract is necessary in an amount not to exceed seventy three thousand nine hundred and seventy one dollars (\$73,971) over the three year term; and 43 44 45 WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission have determined it is in the best interest of the City of Hallandale Beach to authorize the additional expenditure in an amount not to exceed 46 47 seventy three thousand nine hundred seventy one dollars (\$73,971) to expand the scope of custodial services to additional locations within the Public Works Complex. 48 49 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY 50 COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA: 51 52 SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby incorporated herein. 53 54 SECTION 2. Authorization of City Manager. The Mayor and City Commission hereby 55 56 authorize the City Manager to execute a change order with USSI for custodial services to include 57 additional locations within the Public Works Complex for an additional amount not to exceed a total of seventy three thousand nine hundred seventy one dollars (\$73,971) over the three year 58 59 term. 60 **SECTION 3.** Effective Date.
