AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 2 "ADMINISTRATION," **ARTICLE** Ш "BOARDS, COMMITTEES, DISTRICTS AND AUTHORITIES," OF THE HALLANDALE BEACH ORDINANCES CODE **BOARDS** TO STREAMLINE COMMITTEES, ELIMINATE CERTAIN BOARDS AND APPLY GENERAL PROVISIONS TO ALL ADVISORY BOARDS AND COMMITTEES: SPECIFICALLY RENAMING DIVISION 2 AS "ADVISORY BOARDS AND COMMITTEES"; AMENDING SECTION 2-101 RELATING TO THE "BEAUTIFICATION ADVISORY BOARD"; REPEALING DIVISION 3 SECTION 2-121 "CHARTER REVIEW COMMITTEE" AS SUPERSEDED BY CHARTER; REPEALING DIVISION 5, SECTIONS 2-171 TO 2-174 RELATING TO THE "HUMAN SERVICES ADVISORY RENUMBERING AND AMENDING DIVISION 7 "PLANNING ZONING BOARD"; RENUMBERING AND AMENDING DIVISION 8 "PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION BOARD"; RENUMBERING AMENDING DIVISION 10 "PARKS AND RECREATION ADVISORY **BOARD**": PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT: PROVIDING. SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, during the commission workshop meetings of February 13, 2017, March 13, 2017 and April 17, 2017 the City Commission reviewed the composition, powers and responsibilities of all City Advisory Boards and Committees; and

WHEREAS, the city commission directed that certain boards be eliminated and the city administration has proposed others for elimination based on a lack of meetings or purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the City Commission have determined that it is in the best interest of the residents of the City to establish and codify general rules applicable to advisory boards and committees, revise the codes applicable to specific committees to bring them into compliance with the new general rules and eliminate excessive boards and committees.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby incorporated herein.

37	SECTION 2. Chapter 2 "Administration," Article III "Boards, Committees, Districts and
38	Authorities," Division 2 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Hallandale Beach, Florida shall
39	be entitled "Advisory Boards and Committees."
40	
41	SECTION 3. Beautification Advisory Board. Chapter 2, Article III, Division 2, Section
42	2-101 is hereby amended as follows:

44	ARTICLE III BOARDS, COMMITTEES, DISTRICTS AND AUTHORITIES
45	DIVISION 2 ADVISORY BOARDS AND COMMITTEES Beautification Advisory
46	Board

48	Sec. 2-101. – <u>Beautification Advisory Board Established; membership.</u>
49	(a) Established; number of members; appointment. There is established the Hallandale
50	Beach Beautification Advisory Board which shall consist of seven-members appointed by the
51	city commission .
52	(b) Terms. The members shall serve at the pleasure of the city commission.
53	(c) Officers. The beautification advisory board shall select and designate from among its
54	membership a chairman, vice chairman, secretary, and such other officers as may be deemed
55	to be necessary by a majority of the full board. These officers shall serve at the pleasure of the
56	beautification advisory board.
57	(d) Duties. The duties of the beautification advisory board shall be to advise and
58	recommend to the city commission action to be taken in the following matters as they concern
59	beautification factors:
60	(a)(1)-Overall appearance of the city.
61	(b)(2) Long range plans for beautification projects.
62	(c)(3) Such other matters pertaining to the beautification of the city referred to the
63	board by the city commission.
64	
65	SECTION 4. Repeal of Division 3 "Charter Review Committee." Division 3, Section
66	2-121 is superseded by Charter and hereby repealed in its entirety. Section 2-121 shall be
67	reserved for future use.
68	

69	SECTION 5. Repeal of Division 4 "Code Enforcement Board." The Section 2-141 of
70	the Code having previously been repealed by Ord. No. 2017-24, Division 4 "Code Enforcement
71	Board" is hereby repealed for clarity and organizational purposes.
72	
73	SECTION 6. Repeal of Division 5 "Human Services Advisory Board." Division 5,
74	Sections 2-171 through 2-174 are hereby repealed in their entirety and designated as reserved
75	for future use.
76	
77	SECTION 7. Renumbering and Amendment of Division 7. "Planning and Zoning
78	Board." Division 7, Sections 2-231 through 2-232 are hereby repealed and replaced as follows
79	in Division 2, "Advisory Boards and Committees":

81	Sec. 2 -231<u>102</u> Created; membership; responsibilities. Planning and Zoning
82	Board
83	(a) Established. A planning and zoning board is established, which shall consist of seven
84	five (5) members designated in accordance with general advisory board nomination
85	processes, one non-voting member designated by the school board, and two alternates
86	designated by the City Commission at-large.
87	(b)Appointments. The board shall be appointed by a majority vote of the city
88	commission. Each city commissioner shall have one nomination and the mayor and vice
89	mayor shall each have one additional nomination.
90	(c) Terms of office. All board members shall serve at the pleasure of the city commission
91	and shall be appointed for a term of approximately two years, with all terms expiring on
92	the date of the city commission organizational meeting following each biennial city
93	commission election. However, each member shall continue to serve until a successor is
94	appointed. All members are eligible for reappointment.
95	(d) <u>Special Qualifications.</u> Each board member shall be a resident of the city and shall
96	possess experience or interest in the fields of planning, zoning and land development.
97	(e) Officers and voting. The board shall select a chairman and a vice chairman from
98	among its membership. Board members shall vote on all matters before the board
99	except where a legally constituted conflict of interest is established, and all votes shall
100	be-recorded and made public.
101	(f)(b) Responsibilities. The board shall review and make advisory recommendations to

the city commission on applications for the following:

103	(1) Changes to the zoning code text or oπicial zoning map (rezonings);
104	(2) Conditional uses;
105	(3) Variances, other than those variances it has authority to approve pertaining to
106	minor development under section 32-965(a);
107	(4) Changes to the comprehensive land use plan;
108	(5) Development review approval for major development;
109	(6) Application for all plats of subdivision and resubdivisions of land; and
110	(7) Such other matters as deemed appropriate by the city commission.
111	Sec. 2-232. (c) Meetings.
112	(a) Establishment. The planning and zoning board shall establish the time and place for
113	all meetings and shall meet at least once each month on a regularly scheduled date. The
114	board may elect not to hold a meeting when there are no scheduled items; when a
115	quorum cannot be achieved; and during the month of December due to the holiday
116	season. The board may schedule special meetings upon the call of the chairperson.
117	(b)Rules of procedure. The board shall adopt rules of procedure necessary to the
118	conduct of its business provided such procedures do not conflict with any requirements
119	ef this Code.
120	(c) Secretary and quorum. The director shall serve as secretary to the board. A quorum
121	for the conduct of business shall not be less than four members.
122	(d)Procedures.
123	(1) (d)All board meetings shall be open to the public.
124	(2) (e) The director or his designee shall be in attendance at all meetings as an advisor
125	and be permitted to propound questions, give evidence and make recommendations.
126	(3)No action shall be taken on any application unless a quorum is present, and only
127	upon a majority vote-of all-members present and voting. No member shall be permitted
128	to abstain from voting unless he has a conflict of interest as defined in accordance with
129	F.S. ch. 112.
130	(4)Minutes shall be kept of all meetings and proceedings and shall include the vote of
131	each member on each question, and the motion shall state the reason or reasons being
132	based upon the prescribed guides and standards of good zoning and planning
133	principles. If a member is absent or abstains from voting, the minutes shall so indicate.
134	The minutes should reflect that all prerequisites for board action have occurred,
135	including, where applicable, advertisement, notices and postings.

136	(5)The board shall keep accurate records of its minutes which shall be filed, together
137	with all resolutions, with the city clerk and shall be open for public inspection at
138	reasonable times and hours.
139	(6)All board decisions shall be by motion.

141	Sections 2.231 to 2.250 are Reserved.

143	SECTION 8. Renumbering and Amendment of Division 10. "Parks and Recreation
144	dvisory Board." Division 10, Sections 2-291 through 2-293 are hereby repealed and replaced
145	s follows in Division 2, "Advisory Boards and Committees":
146	Sec. 2-291103 Created and established; membership. Parks and Recreation
147	dvisory Board
148 149	(a) There is created and established a parks and recreation advisory board for the city, which shall consist of ten residents of the city. Each of the five commissioners will
150	appoint two board members to the parks and recreation advisory board.
151	Sec. 2-292 Officers; meetings.
152 153 154 155	The parks and recreation advisory board is authorized to elect one of its members as chair and one of its members as vice chair. A copy of the minutes shall be filed with the city clerk pursuant to the policies and procedures for boards and committees, as amended from time to time.
156	Sec. 2-293. (b) Functions and duties. The parks and recreation advisory board shall
157	have the following functions and duties:
158 159 160	(1) Make recommendations concerning the operation of all public parks, playgrounds, undeveloped park lands, public beaches and other recreational facilities within the city.
161 162 163 164	(2) Recommend to the city commission and the city manager from time to time actions which it believes the city commission should take with reference to the acquisition, development and maintenance of parks, playgrounds and recreational facilities in the city.
165 166	(3) Recommend rules and regulations for the operation of city parks, playgrounds and public recreational facilities.
167 168	Sections 2-291 to 2-300 are Reserved.

171	SECTION 9. Renumbering and Amendment of Division 8. "Public Transportation
172	Board." Division 8, "Public Transportation Board," Sections 2-251 through 2-253 are hereby
173	repealed and replaced as follows in Division 2, "Advisory Boards and Committees":
174	Sec. 2- 251 104 Created; purpose; duties generally. Public Transportation, Traffic
175	and Parking Advisory Board

There is created and established the Hallandale Beach Public Transportation/Flood Mitigation, Traffic and Parking Board, which board is established for the purposes of assisting the city commission in planning, developing and implementing a mass transit program and methods of disseminating information concerning flood damage prevention and addressing the issues of traffic and parking throughout the city. The board shall serve in an advisory capacity to the city commission regarding matters related to the city's mass transit program, parking, and traffic reduction initiatives issues involving flood-mitigation, and the dissemination of information concerning flood damage prevention. It shall exercise and perform such other duties as may be established by the city commission.

Sec. 2-252. - Members.

The public transportation/flood-mitigation board-shall consist of seven members.

Sec. 2-253. - Organization; quorum; meetings.

The members of the public transportation/flood mitigation board shall-elect a chairman and such other officers as deemed necessary or desirable. A majority of the board shall-constitute a quorum. No meeting shall-be held-except as provided under-this division and unless a quorum of the board is present, but every matter upon which a vote is taken shall require at least four votes. The members shall set the time, date and place of the regular meetings of the board All-meetings of the board shall be open, and all members shall serve without compensation. The board may adopt such rules of procedure as it may deem necessary.
