RESOLUTION NO. 2019-026

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT THE GRANT APPLICATIONS FOR THE 45TH YEAR CDBG PROGRAM FOR THE AFTER SCHOOL TUTORIAL PROGRAM AND PUBLIC WORKS IMPROVEMENTS IN THE NW QUADRANT (DRAINAGE, SIDEWALKS, REGRADING/SODDING OF SWALES AND OTHER RELATED INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS) FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED FOURTEEN THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED (\$214,200) DOLLARS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL RELATED DOCUMENTS TO EFFECTUATE THE SUBMITTAL OF THE GRANT APPLICATIONS, ACCEPT GRANT AWARDS, AND EXECUTE ANY AND ALL GRANT RELATED DOCUMENTS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program, run by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, is a flexible program that provides communities with resources to address a wide range of community development needs; and

WHEREAS, cities participating in the Broward County CDBG program receive an allocation based on a Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) funding formula; and

WHEREAS, the formula generally takes into consideration community housing conditions, population and poverty indicators; and

WHEREAS, the City plans to pursue two (2) projects during this CDBG funding cycle in conjunction with the Friends of Hepburn Center Non-profit. The City hosted a public meeting on March 20th wherein residents were advised of the City's plan to continue the After School Tutorial Program at the Hepburn Center and implement infrastructure upgrades under the City's application; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The above clauses are incorporated in full in this Resolution.

SECTION 2. City Manager's Authorization. The Mayor and City Commission hereby authorize the City Manager to submit the grant application for the 45th Year CDBG

Grant Program Project Public Works Improvements in the NW Quadrant (drainage, sidewalks, regrading/sodding of swales and other related infrastructure improvements) and for After School Tutorial Program for a total combined amount not to exceed two hundred fourteen thousand two hundred (\$214,200.00) dollars.

SECTION 3. The City Manager is authorized to establish accounts and implement funding for the grant projects. Further, the City Manager is authorized to execute all funding agreements with Broward County and appropriate funding allocation documents following approval.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
