20 21	WHEREAS, the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program, run by
21	the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, is a flexible program that
23	provides communities with resources to address a wide range of community development
24	needs; and
25	WHEREAS, cities participating in the Broward County CDBG program receive an
26	allocation based on a Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) funding
27	formula; and
28	WHEREAS, the formula generally takes into consideration community housing
29	conditions, population and poverty indicators; and
30	WHEREAS, the City plans to pursue two (2) projects during this CDBG funding
31	cycle in conjunction with the Friends of Hepburn Center Non-profit. The City hosted a
32	public meeting on March 20 th wherein residents were advised of the City's plan to continue
33	the After School Tutorial Program at the Hepburn Center and implement infrastructure
34	upgrades under the City's application; and

Grant Program Project Public Works Improvements in the NW Quadrant (drainage,
sidewalks, regrading/sodding of swales and other related infrastructure improvements)
and for After School Tutorial Program for a total combined amount not to exceed two
hundred fourteen thousand two hundred (\$214,200.00) dollars.

47 <u>SECTION 3.</u> The City Manager is authorized to establish accounts and 48 implement funding for the grant projects. Further, the City Manager is authorized to 49 execute all funding agreements with Broward County and appropriate funding allocation 50 documents following approval.
