AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING SECTION 2-3, "LOBBYISTS; REGISTRATION AND DISCLOSURE; ENFORCEMENT" TO REVISE REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS TO REQUIRE REGISTRATION PRIOR TO LOBBYING FOR EACH INDIVIDUAL PRINCIPAL AND UPDATE THE LOBBYIST REGISTRATION FEE; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Staff Summary:

Background:

The city currently requires lobbyists to register annually to disclose all their lobbying clients for the past year on a single registration.

The attached ordinance amends the code as follows:

- 1) Requires a lobbyist to file a disclosure every time they are engaged by a new principal and then again, every year, they plan to lobby for that principal.
- 2) Requires disclosure to be filed *prior* to the commencement of any lobbying activities
- 3) Requires the disclosure of the amount of compensation to be received by the lobbyist.
- 4) Removes reference to the amount of the lobbying fee and leaves it to be se only by resolution.

If the ordinance is approved on first reading, the sponsor plans to present a companion resolution on second reading setting the lobbying fee at \$100 per registration (per principal). It is currently charged at \$50 and only one registration is required per year.
