16	WHEREAS, the MPO's Complete Streets and other Localized Initiatives Grant Program
17	(CSLIP) provides funding for small local transportation projects which improve the safety and
18	mobility for all transportation users in Broward County; and
19	
20	WHEREAS, a complete street is a street where the entire right of way is planned,
21	designed, and operated for all modes of transportation and all users regardless of age or ability.
22	Pedestrians, bicyclists, transit riders, and motorists of all ages and abilities must be able to safely
23	move along and across a complete street. Complete streets make it easy to cross the street, walk
24	to shops, catch the bus, and bike to work; and
25	
26	WHEREAS, the proposed application is for a complete street revitalization project on NW
27	3rd Street from Dixie Highway west to NW 5th Terrace. This project addresses deficiencies in the
28	existing segment from Dixie Highway to NW 6 Avenue. NW 3rd Street can be characterized as a
29	slum and blighted corridor with a lack of formalized on-street parking and gaps in the existing
30	narrow sidewalk network; and
31	
32	WHEREAS, the proposed project would implement formalized parallel on-street parking,
33	maintain one (1) continuous travel lane in each direction, address all American with Disabilities
34	Act (ADA) deficiencies, provide buffered bicycle lanes, install curb and gutter drainage, increase
35	landscape opportunities, and result in a continuous 7-foot wide sidewalk network from U.S. 1 to

NW 6th Avenue (NW 5th Terrace); and

**WHEREAS**, if the grant is awarded, the State's funding will become available in five years; the City will be required to program its matching funds in the same timeframe. The estimated cost of construction is \$1,726,971. The City's required match is estimated to be \$377,387; and

WHEREAS, in order to obtain the funding the agency requires a commitment from the City to fund the sidewalk work within the existing ROW on the north and south sides of the road between Dixie Highway and NW 5th Terrace; the City must also commit to fund the landscaping, utilities, all roadway maintenance, and any portion of the project construction costs that exceeds three (3) million dollars; and

WHEREAS, City Administration is recommending the Commission endorses the NW 3rd Street Complete Street Revitalization Project grant application in order to be awarded funding from the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization's Complete Streets and other Localized Initiatives Program, agrees to have the Florida Department of Transportation fully administer the design and construction phases of the project and deliver the projects on the city's behalf, and commits to maintain the roadways and signal systems after the projects are completed; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Commission have determined that the administration's recommendations are in the best interest of the City and its residents.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

**SECTION 1.** The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. Approval of NW 3rd Street Complete Street Revitalization Project. The Mayor and City Commission hereby approves of the NW 3rd Street Complete Street Revitalization Project as proposed and agrees identify and appropriate funding as necessary to complete the project if the contemplated grant funding is awarded. It is further agreed that the Florida Department of Transportation will fully administer the design and construction phases of the project and deliver the projects on the city's behalf as part of the grant award. The City will then maintain the roadways and signal systems after the projects are completed.
