14	WHEREAS, a new law punishes homosexual sex and adultery with death in the		
15	small southeast Asian kingdom of Brunei; and		
16			
17	WHEREAS, any individuals found guilty of the offenses will be stoned to death,		
18	according to a new penal code. The punishment will be "witnessed by a group of Muslims"		
19	according to news reports; and		
20			
21	WHEREAS, human rights groups have expressed horror at the penal code, which		
22	will also order amputation as a punishment for theft, and called for the international		
23	community must urgently condemn Brunei's move to put these cruel penalties into		
24	practice; and		
25			
26	WHEREAS, there was also broad international outcry when in 2014 Brunei		
27	became the first country in the region to adopt Sharia law, an Islamic legal system which		
28	outlines strict corporal punishments, but even with more international pressure, the small		
29	nation said it has no plans to halt the law; and		
30			
31	WHEREAS, the City of Hallandale Beach is welcoming and diverse community		
32	that wishes to stand with the LGBTQ community and denounce inhumane treatment of		
33	any and all people; and		
34 25	WHEREAS the Mover and City Commission with to join other world beders in		
35	WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission wish to join other world leaders in		
36 37	denouncing the country's harsh practices and stand by the LGBT community.

49	and the Clerk is directed to forward to all appropriate parties.
