Short Title:

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, URGING THE BROWARD COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS TO PROCEED EXPEDITIOUSLY IN CHOOSING A LOCATION OF THE P(25) RADIO SYSTEM TOWER; DIRECTING THE CLERK TO PROVIDE A COPY OF THE RESOLUTION TO THE APPROPRIATE OFFICIALS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Staff Summary:

The lack of a decision regarding the final tower location for the County-wide radio system is delaying implementation of the much needed county-wide Public Safety Radio System.

Why Action is Necessary:

Action by the County Commission is necessary. Unless and until it chooses a location and implements the final tower, the new radio system can not be made functional. The proposed resolution urges the County to proceed to make a decision.

CURRENT SITUATION:

There are two potential locations, either on the CIRC Tower in Hollywood or on a portion of land which is currently part of Broward County's West Lake Park.

Fiscal Impact:

The City of Hallandale Beach has expended significant funds buyin new radios in preparation for the new County-wide radio system. .Furthermore, all City's are contributing to the cost of implementing the new system which is scheduled to be operational by the end of the year.

Proposed Action:

Approve the Resolution urging the Broward County Commission to proceed expeditiously.
