STAFF SUMMARY:

Summary:

Pursuant to Florida Statute 218.39, and Article V, Division 2, Section 5.04, of the City of Hallandale Beach Charter, the City Commission shall conduct an independent annual audit of all City Accounts by an independent Certified Public Accountant (CPA) firm.

The CAFR is due to the State and other stakeholder agencies by June 30, 2019.

Background:

In 2017, the City Commission selected Certified Public Accounting firm (CPA) Maulding & Jenkins, LLC, via RFP 2016-2017-004 to perform audit services for an amount not to exceed one hundred seventy five thousand (\$175,000) dollars for a two year term.

Current Situation:

The City engaged the CPA firm of Mauldin & Jenkin, LLC to perform its audit for Fiscal Year ended September 30, 2018.

A representative of Maulding & Jenkins LLC will provide a brief presentation of the audit results to the City Commission at its June 19, 2019 meeting, and staff will ensure that the final audit report is placed on file and submitted to pertinent agencies by the June 30, 2019 deadline.

Why Action is Necessary:

Pursuant to Florida Statute 218.39, and Article V, Division 2, Section 5.04, of the City of Hallandale Beach Charter, the City Commission shall conduct an independent annual audit of all City Accounts by an independent Certified Public Accountant (CPA) firm.
