20	Services Agreement to provide all support services necessary to ensure the safety and well-being		
21	of all residents and visitors during a disaster or emergency event; and		
22 23	WHEREAS, an invitation to award RFP #FY2015-2016-007 for Disaster Debris Monitoring		
24	Services and Financial Recovery Assistance was emailed to ninety-two (92) vendors, and the		
25 26	Minority Business Development agencies to release the Request for Proposal (RFP); and		
27	WHEREAS, two (2) bids were submitted on March 8, 2016. The City Administration		
28	evaluated responses from both vendors and selected Eisman and Russo as the highest-ranking		
29	firm; and

31	WHEREAS, the services are on a per needed basis and will be determined only after a		
32	hurricane has occurred and debris removal is necessary; and

34	WHEREAS, due to the uncertain nature and the cost associated with such emergency		
35	events, it is not possible to determine the fiscal impact of the contract; and		
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37	WHEREAS, the initial term of the Agreement was for three (3) years, beginning on October		
38	5, 2016. The City has the option of extending the contract for three (3) additional one (1) year		
39 40	terms not to exceed a total contract term of six (6) years		
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43	WHEREAS, the City also seeks to amend the agreement to incorporate terms required by		
44	FEMA; and
