## RESOLUTION NO. 2019-

A RESOLUTION OF CHAIR AND BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE HALLANDALE BEACH COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING A CHANGE ORDER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$80,900 TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE **HALLANDALE** COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY AND ARTSERVE. INC. FOR A TOTAL AGREEMENT AMOUNT NOT EXCEED \$105,900; AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO EXECUTE THE CHANGE ORDER AND ANY DOCUMENTS AS NECESSARY TO AMEND THE AGREEMENT AND IMPLEMENT THE CHANGE ORDER; AND PROVIDING AN **EFFECTIVE DATE.** 

**WHEREAS**, the mission of the Hallandale Beach Community Redevelopment Agency ("HBCRA") is to promote economic development and enhance the quality of life by eliminating and preventing blighted conditions through the facilitation of community partnerships, business growth, job creation, and neighborhood rehabilitation; and

**WHEREAS,** during the past year, the Board of Directors of the HBCRA and HBCRA Staff have discussed various art initiatives within the HBCRA Community Redevelopment Area ("CRA") including artwork on traffic signal boxes, art on fire hydrants, new decorative manhole covers, and murals; and

WHEREAS, in March of 2012, the HBCRA adopted the Community Redevelopment Plan (the "Plan") wherein specific areas within the CRA boundaries were designated as Special Redevelopment Areas and Districts and the HBCRA Plan also stated that the CRA's strategic priorities included creating an image and sense of community for CRA area; and

WHEREAS, on February 11, 2019 the HBCRA prepared a memorandum to the Board of Directors of the HBCRA describing the implementation of the "12 Months of Art" Program, which memorandum detailed that ArtServe, Inc. ("ArtServe") would assist with the implementation, marketing and execution of the Program, as ArtServe is a multidisciplinary arts nonprofit organization that empowers artists and cultural entities to achieve their vision, improve the cultural fabric of their community; and

WHEREAS, the procurement of the services through ArtServe in an amount not to exceed \$25,000 were authorized in accordance with HBCRA By-Laws, Section 2.10 Policies and Procedures, waiving the procurement requirement of quote for any expenditure over \$2,500, which waiver of the procurement process was authorized by the HBCRA Executive Director per Section 2.10 which states that the HBCRA reserves the right to amend or adjust these policies as they pertain to the HBCRA in writing and with the approval of the Executive Director in a manner that best suits the HBCRA; and

**WHEREAS**, HBCRA Staff recommends that the Board of Directors of the HBCRA approve a change order to ArtServe's existing Agreement, providing an additional \$80,900 to ArtServe for

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the administration, production and execution of the "12 Months of Art" Program with a total 47 Agreement amount not to exceed \$105,900; and 48 49 50 WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the HBCRA desires to approve a change order to ArtServe's existing Agreement, providing an additional \$90,000 to ArtServe for the administration, 51 production and execution of the "12 Months of Art" Program with a total Agreement amount not 52 53 to exceed \$105,900. 54 55 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CHAIR AND BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE HALLANDALE BEACH COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY: 56 57 Section 1. Recitals. The recitals in the whereas clauses are true and correct, and incorporated into this Resolution. 58 59 Section 2. Approval of Change Order. The Change Order to ArtServe's existing Agreement in the amount of \$90,000 for the administration, production and execution of the "12" 60 Months of Art" Program with a total Agreement amount not to exceed \$115,000 is hereby 61 62 approved. Section 3. Execution of Change Order. The Executive Director is hereby authorized to 63 64 execute and deliver the Change Order and any other documents as necessary to amend the Agreement and implement the Change Order. 65 Section 4. Implementation of Change Order. The Executive Director is hereby authorized 66 to take all steps necessary and appropriate to implement the terms and conditions of the Change 67 68 Order and any other documents as necessary to amend the Agreement and implement the Change Order. 69 70 Section 5. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval.
