



ARC South Florida Region

- The South Florida Region is already in the community delivering preparedness messages to the citizens of Broward & Miami-Dade counties leading up to Hurricane Season.
- We are actively engaged with Broward & Miami-Dade counties and assist in training shelter workers as needed by the counties. This is a partnership that we began prior to hurricane season two years ago.
- We've committed to supporting evacuation shelters pre- landfall, and will operate shelters as needed 72 hours post landfall in Broward & Miami-Dade counties this hurricane season.

- Staff & volunteers have begun attending updated training classes in preparation of hurricane season.
- In June 2019, the South Florida Region will conduct a comprehensive disaster relief operation training.
- Our teams are ready to respond in the community after a hurricane, should the need arise.
