FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, BROADSPECTRUM INFRASTRUCTURE, INC., AND CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH IN CASE NO: CACE 17-011423 (08) IN THE CIRCUIT COURT OF THE SEVENTEENTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT, BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY ATTORNEY TO ENTER INTO SETTLEMENT, FOR PERSONAL INJURIES SHE SUSTAINED, IN EXCHANGE FOR THE EXECUTION OF THE APPROPRIATE RELEASE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
16	WHEREAS, Deena Aboulafia filed suit against the City of Hallandale Beach for
17	alleged injuries she sustained to her left wrist on December 11, 2014. Ms. Aboulafia while
18	walking pass the bus shelter located at 1110 East Hallandale Beach Boulevard tripped
19	and fell on an uneven portion of sidewalk area that connects to the paved area of the
20	sidewalk; and
21	
22	WHEREAS, Ms. Aboulafia treated at the hospital where she underwent surgery to
23	her left wrist and spent four (4) days receiving rehabilitative and post-operative care and
24	treatment; and
25	
26	WHEREAS, the City has engaged in a strategic defense, including discovery and
27	fact-finding investigative preparation for trial; and
28	
29	WHEREAS, the parties have determined that the resolution of their difference in a
30	manner favorable to their respective interests are best obtained through a settlement of
31	the issues as opposed to protracted trial, which will require the expenditure of significant
32	funds and resources to both parties; and
33	
34	WHEREAS, the City Administration requests authorization to ratify the negotiated
35	settlement amount of sixty thousand dollars and no cents (\$60,000.00). This amount will
36	be remitted in the form of U.S. currency in the amount of sixty-thousand dollars and no
37	cents (\$60,000.00); and

39	WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission, being fully advised of the facts of
40	this matter, believe it is in the best interest of the City to resolve this litigation in lieu of
41	proceeding to trial and accepts the recommendation.

43	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY
44	COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

46	SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are confirmed as true and
47	incorporated herein.

49	SECTION 2. Ratify Settlement. The Mayor and City Commission hereby ratify
50	the negotiated settlement in the matter of Deena Aboulafia v. Florida Department of
51	Transportation, Broadspectrum Infrastructure, Inc., and City of Hallandale Beach.
52	
53	SECTION 3. City Manager and City Attorney Authorization. The Mayor and
54	City Commission hereby authorize the City Manager and City Attorney to settle litigation
55	styled Deena Aboulafia v. Florida Department of Transportation, Broadspectrum
56	Infrastructure, Inc., and City of Hallandale Beach in Case no: CACE 17- 011423 (08) in
57	the Circuit Court of the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit, Broward County for the total sum of
58	sixty thousand dollars and no cents (\$60,000.00). This amount will be remitted in the form
59	of U.S. currency in the amount of sixty thousand dollars and no cents (\$60,000.00), in
60	exchange for the appropriate release executed by the Plaintiff.
61	
62	SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon
63	its passage and adoption.
