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RESOLUTION NO. 2017-115

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO UTILIZE THE SOUTHEAST FLORIDA GOVERNMENTAL PURCHASING COOPERATIVE GROUP CONTRACT PURSUANT TO BID #17-22B BETWEEN THE CITY OF TAMARAC AND LHOIST NORTH AMERICA OF ALABAMA, LLC FOR THE PURCHASE OF QUICKLIME IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED NINETY FIVE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED NINETY (\$195,490.00) DOLLARS AS PROVIDED FOR IN THE FISCAL YEAR 2017-2018 BUDGET; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 23-9 of the City of Hallandale Beach ("City") Code, the City Manager shall have the authority to join with other units of government in cooperative purchasing plans or to purchase pursuant to formal written contracts or competitive bids of other governmental units, when the best interests of the city would be served, subject to the requirement that purchases in excess of \$50,000 require City Commission approval; and

WHEREAS, the City participates in the Southeast Florida Governmental Purchasing Cooperative ("Co-op") which is comprised of governmental entities to provide cost savings and cost avoidances to member entities by utilizing the buying power of combined requirements for common basic items; and

WHEREAS, the City presently purchases quicklime, a supply used in water treatment plant operations, through its participation in the Co-op; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tamarac, acting as lead agency for the Co-op awarded Bid #17-22B to Lhoist North America of Alabama, LLC through Resolution R-2017-87 for a term of three (3) years, beginning November 1, 2017 with up to three (3) one (1) year renewals to be exercised based upon satisfactory performance ("Co-op contract"); and

WHEREAS, the City Administration projects that the expenditure for quicklime for Fiscal Year 2017-2018 will be one hundred ninety five thousand four hundred ninety (\$195,490) dollars; and

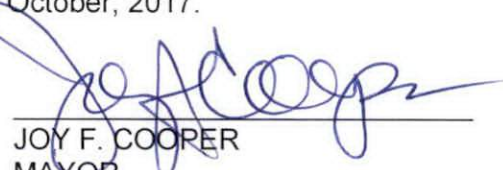
40 **WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Commission have determined that it is in the best
41 interest of the residents of the City of Hallandale Beach to utilize the Co-op contract
42 pursuant to Bid #17-22B between the City of Tamarac and Lhoist North America of
43 Alabama, LLC to purchase quicklime for water treatment plant operations.

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45 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY**
46 **COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:**

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48 **SECTION 1. City Manager Authorization.** The Mayor and City Commission
49 hereby authorize the City Manager to purchase quicklime utilizing the Southeast Florida
50 Governmental Purchasing Cooperative contract pursuant to Bid #17-22B between the City
51 of Tamarac and Lhoist North America of Alabama, LLC for an amount not to exceed one
52 hundred ninety five thousand four hundred ninety (\$195,490) dollars as budgeted for in
53 fiscal year FY 2017-2018. The City Manager is authorized to take necessary actions to
54 implement the project.

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56 **SECTION 2. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon
57 its passage and adoption.
