17	WHEREAS purposent to Section 22.6 Award of Contracts and 22.9 Unique
18	WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 23-6, Award of Contracts, and 23-8, Unique
19	Circumstances, the City Commission may declare unique circumstances as an exception to the
20	requirements of competitive bidding;
21	
22	WHEREAS, unlike the procurement of most services, insurance products must be
23	obtained through a broker who is paid a commission by the insurance company and not the city;
24	
25	WHEREAS, the City participates in the Florida Municipal Insurance Trust Fund, which is
26	administered by the Florida League of Cities and limited only to municipalities, to insure its
27	physical facilities; and
28	
29	WHEREAS, this trust fund provides property insurance for all City facilities which currently
30	totals \$94,015,824 for buildings and \$6,638,000 for content coverage. There is a \$25,000
31	deductible per incident except for windstorm damage, which is 5% per value of the building
32	deductible; and
33	
34	WHEREAS, the premium to renew coverage increased as a result of increased property
35	rates, the addition of Bluesten Park facility, and the increase in value to Ingalls Park and Marina
36	Dock facilities; and
37	
38	WHEREAS, the property insurance for all City facilities provided by this trust fund
39	represents the cost to replace damaged property with property of like kind and quality; and

41	WHEREAS, the City Administration is recommending that the City renew its current
42	property insurance with Florida Municipal Trust Fund for the total sum of Six Hundred Fifty-Sever
43	Thousand Six Eight Four (\$657,684.00) Dollars for fiscal year 2019-2020; and
44 45	WHEREAS, the City believes it is in the best interest of the City to renew the City's curren
46	property insurance through the Florida Municipal Insurance Trust Fund.
47 48	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY

50 51	SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are adopted herein.

53	SECTION 2. Declaration of Unique Circumstances. The Mayor and City
54	Commission declare a Unique Circumstance pursuant to Chapter 23, Section 8(5) of the City
55 5-5	Hallandale Beach Code of Ordinances.

57	SECTION 3. City Manager Authorization. The Mayor and City Commission hereby
58	approve the renewal of the City's property insurance through the Florida Municipal Insurance
59	Trust Fund in the amount of Six Hundred Fifty-Seven Thousand Six Eight Four (\$657,684.00
60	Dollars as provided for in fiscal year 2019-2020 budget and authorize the City Manager to execute
61	all related documents to effectuate the renewal of the City's property insurance.
62 63	SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its
64	passage and adoption.
