4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11 12 13 14 15 16 17 18	A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, DECLARING A UNIQUE CIRCUMSTANCE FOR THE BROKERAGE OF MUNICIPAL INSURANCE PRODUCTS; RATIFYING THE RENEWAL OF THE CITY'S EXCESS WORKERS' COMPENSATION INSURANCE WITH FLORIDA MUNICIPAL TRUST FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY-TWO THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED FIFTEEN DOLLARS (\$182,315); AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL RELATED DOCUMENTS TO EFFECTUATE THE INSURANCE AS PROVIDED FOR IN FISCAL YEAR 2019-2020 BUDGET; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
19 20	WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 23-6, Award of Contracts, and 23-8, Unique
21	Circumstances, the City Commission may declare unique circumstances as an exception
22	to the requirements of competitive bidding; and
23	
24	WHEREAS, unlike the procurement of most services, insurance products must be
25	obtained through a broker who is paid a commission by the insurance company and not
26	the city;
27	
28	WHEREAS, market forces that typically apply during a competitive procurement
29	process are further restricted because the City participates in the Florida Municipal
30	Insurance Trust Fund, which is administered by the Florida League of Cities and limited
31	only to municipalities, to insure its physical facilities; and
32 33	WHEREAS, the City is required to comply with the provisions of Florida Statute
34	440 by maintaining a Self-Insurance Fund; and
35	440 by maintaining a deli medianee i and, and
36	WHEREAS, the purpose is to ensure that if an employee is injured on the job, the
37	worker will receive quick and efficient disability and medical benefits, if needed; and
38 39	WHEREAS, there are numerous governmental agencies throughout the State of
40	Florida that participate in this pooled program; and

42	WHEREAS, the City Administration is recommending that the City retain Florida
43	Municipal Trust Fund as its workers' compensation insurance provider for the total sum of
44	one hundred eighty-two thousand three hundred fifteen (\$182,315.00) dollars, subject to
45	the annual audit adjustment; and
46 47	WHEREAS, the City believes that the renewal of the City's workers' compensation
48	insurance through the Florida Municipal Insurance Trust Fund is the most cost effective
49	for the City and in the best interest of the residents of the City.
50 51	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY
52	COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:
53 54	SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are adopted herein.
55	
56	SECTION 2. Declaration of Unique Circumstances. The Mayor and City
57	Commission declare a Unique Circumstance pursuant to Chapter 23, Section 8(5) of the
58	City of Hallandale Beach Code of Ordinances.
59	
60	SECTION 3. City Manager Authorization. The Mayor and City
61	Commission hereby approve the renewal of the City's workers' compensation insurance
62	through the Florida Municipal Insurance Trust Fund in the estimated amount of one
63	hundred eighty two thousand three hundred fifteen (\$182,315.00) dollars as provided for
64	in fiscal year 2019-2020 budget, subject to the adjustment resulting from the required
65	annual audit and authorizing the City Manager to execute all related documents to
66	effectuate the renewal of the City's workers' compensation insurance.
67 68	SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect
69	immediately upon its passage and adoption.
