3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11 12	A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT (ILA) WITH BROWARD COUNTY TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE CITY COMMUNITY BUS SERVICE; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT AND RELATED DOCUMENTS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
13	WHEREAS, the Community Bus System is a free service provided to residents
14	and visitors of Hallandale Beach, consisting of 4 routes with 5 buses; and
15	
16	WHEREAS, on June 5, 2019, the City of Hallandale Beach City Commission
17	considered and approved the expansion of the minibus service routes to better serve
18	under-represented Hallandale Beach communities, increase ridership and reduce
19	headways of the system to 25-35 minutes; and
20	
21	WHEREAS, the service expansion includes adding one additional bus to each
22	route for a total of 9 buses on 4 routes (Exhibit 3 - Resolution 2019-044); and
23	
24	WHEREAS, the service is currently contracted out to a company, Limousines of
25	South Florida (LOSF), which provides the buses, the drivers, maintenance of the bus
26	and fuel. The current contract was set to expire on September 30, 2019. However, on
27	June 20, 2019, the City of Hallandale Beach City Commission considered and approved
28	an extension of the contract on a month-to-month basis for a period not exceeding 6
29	months (Exhibit 4 - Resolution 2019-046); and
30	
31	WHEREAS, a Request for Proposal (RFP) # 2018-2019-007 is currently in
32	progress to select a new vendor to operate the City's community shuttle service. The
33	results of this RFP, included awarded vendor must be approved by the City Commission;
34	and
35	
36	

WHEREAS, until recently, the community shuttle service has been funded by multiple sources, including Broward County Transit Grant, Hallandale Beach Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA) contribution and the City's Transportation Fund. Funding for the services from Broward County is accomplished through an Interlocal Agreement (ILA) between Broward County and the City of Hallandale Beach. The current ILA expires September 30, 2019; and
WHEREAS, on August 21, 2019, Broward County approved the Transportation System Surtax Interlocal Agreement, which will use the Transportation surtax proceeds to fund all reasonable and necessary operating, maintenance and capital costs for local community bus services; and
WHEREAS, funding from Broward County is accomplished through an Interlocal Agreement (ILA) between Broward County and the City of Hallandale Beach; and
WHEREAS, the County and City propose to enter into a new ILA for a term of three (3) years, expiring September 30, 2022, with the option for two one year renewal periods; and
WHEREAS, the Hallandale Beach City Commission's approval is requested to authorize a new ILA between Broward County and the City of Hallandale Beach to receive funding at a rate of forty-six dollars and ninety four cents (\$46.94) for the total vehicle hours beginning October 1, 2019; and
WHEREAS, city Administration recommends that the Mayor and City Commission approve the ILA with Broward County for funding to assist in the operation of the five (5) Routes of the City's Community Bus Service and authorize the City Manager to execute the Interlocal Agreement and to take such action as is necessary or appropriate to implement, administer, and enforce said agreement and all subsequent amendments thereto on behalf of the City of Hallandale Beach.

COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

71	SECTION 1. Approval and City Manager's Authority. The Mayor and Cit
72	Commission hereby approve the Interlocal Agreement with Broward County for th
73	partial funding of the City's Community Bus Service, and further authorize the Cit
74	Manager to execute said agreement in substantially the same form as attached heret
75	as exhibit 2. The City Manager is authorized to take such action as is necessary of
76	appropriate to implement, administer, and enforce said agreement and all subsequer
77	amendments thereto on behalf of the City of Hallandale Beach.

79	SECTION 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediatel
80	upon its passage and adoption.
