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4 A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF  
5 THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA  
6 ESTABLISHING AN AD HOC CENSUS 2020 COMPLETE  
7 COUNT COMMITTEE FOR THE CITY OF HALLANDALE  
8 BEACH, FLORIDA; APPOINTING THE COMMITTEE CHAIR AND  
9 DESIGNATING THE NUMBER OF COMMITTEE MEMBERS;  
10 ESTABLISHING COMMITTEE FUNCTIONS; AND PROVIDING  
11 FOR EFFECTIVE DATE.  
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13 WHEREAS, every ten years the U.S. Census Bureau counts residents across the country  
14 and April 1, 2020 is the official deadline for residents to submit their Census 2020 form; and

15 WHEREAS, a Complete Count ensures accurate Census data that is critical for  
16 government programs, policies and decision making, including federal representation and funding  
17 of programs such as new roads and transportation, housing, schools, supplemental nutrition  
18 assistance (SNAP), health insurance and emergency services; and

19 WHEREAS, undercounted communities do not receive their fair share of federal funds. A  
20 recent study from George Washington University shows \$1,445 in federal funds is distributed  
21 annually for each resident counted in Florida; and

22 WHEREAS, six subcommittees have been established by Broward County as part of the  
23 Census 2020 Complete Count Committee: City-County Coordination, Cultural and Ethnic,  
24 Interfaith Institutions, Hard to Enumerate, Promotions, and Recruitment and Training; and

25 WHEREAS, the purpose of the Complete Count Committee is to raise awareness of the  
26 importance of Census 2020, assertively reach out to hard to enumerate groups, and encourage  
27 participation in the Census; and

28 WHEREAS, the City of Hallandale Beach City Commission wishes to establish a  
29 Complete Count Committee charged with the responsibility of ensuring that all City residents  
30 participate in the year 2020 Census; and

31 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF  
32 THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA THAT:

33 Section 1. There is hereby established an ad hoc advisory committee known as the City  
34 of Hallandale Beach Complete Count Census 2020 Committee ("Committee"). The Committee

shall consist of up to 10 members representing a broad section of the City of Hallandale Beach's population. The Committee members composition shall provide representation from civic associations, community-based organizations, the business community, and organizations that serve the population that is most likely to be undercounted.

**Section 2.** The Mayor and City Commission hereby appoint \_\_\_\_\_ as an ex officio Committee chair.

**Section 3.** The City Manager is hereby directed to appoint no less than four members of the administration, preferably those whose functions can contribute meaningfully to the work and purpose of the Committee.

**Section 4.** The remaining members of the committee shall be appointed by the City Commission At-large.

**Section 5.** Quorum shall consist of a majority of the filled seats of the committee.

**Section 6.** The function of the Committee shall be as follows:

- a. Coordinate efforts in partnership with a Broward County agency staff liaison;
- b. Participate in the six subcommittees that have been established by Broward County as part of the Census 2020 Complete Count Committee: City-County Coordination, Cultural and Ethnic, Interfaith Institutions, Hard to Enumerate, Promotions, and Recruitment and Training;
- c. Establish a list of groups that will be targeted for priority attention in an effort to encourage their members to be counted in the year 2020 Census;
- d. Raise awareness of the importance of Census 2020;
- e. Assertively reach out to hard to enumerate groups; and,
- f. Encourage participation in the Census.

**Section 7.** The Committee shall sunset upon completion of its activities or within six (6) months of its establishment.
