4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11 12 13 14	AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE ADOPTED BUDGET FOR FY 18/19 TO REFLECT THE REVENUES, EXPENDITURES, APPROPRIATIONS AND OTHER MISCELLANEOUS BUDGET ADJUSTMENTS; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
15	WHEREAS, Section 166.241 authorizes a municipality to amend its adopted
16	budget anytime during the fiscal year or within sixty (60) days after the end of the fiscal
17	year for which the budget applied; and
18	
19	WHEREAS, Section 166.241 (4)(c) provides the process for a municipality to
20	amend an adopted budget when the amendment will change the expenditures and
21	revenues; and
22 23	WHEREAS, the FY 2018-2019 adopted budget did not reflect the revenue,
24	expenditures, appropriations and other miscellaneous adjustments reflected herein; and
25	WHEREAS, this proposed budget amendment is still within the allotted time
26	pursuant to Florida Statutes; and
27 28 29 30	WHEREAS, the City Administration proposes that the FY 2018-2019 adopted budget be amended to include the following transactions:
31	The Capital Lease Proceeds were not budgeted and needs to be budgeted in
32	FY 18/19 to acknowledge the dollars for the purchase of the equipment in the
33	amount of \$448,549.
34	2. Increase the Workers' Compensation Fund by recognizing unanticipated
35	revenues and use of fund balance to cover claim expenses greater than

36	anticipated. In FY 18/19 staff budgeted \$768,836 for claims expenses. During
37	the year, the City had multiple settlements totaling \$1,122,416. The
38	amendment to the FY 2018-19 Budget will not exceed \$400,000; and
39	WHEREAS, this budget amendment will amend the FY 2018-2019 adopted budget
40	as indicated in Attachment A of this ordinance; and
41	
42	WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission have determined that it is in the best
43	interest of the City and its residents to amend the FY 2018-2019 adopted budget as
44	reflected in the attachment; and
45	
46	WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission have determined that this proposed
47	budget amendment is timely under Florida Statutes 166.241 and is being adopted in the
48	same manner as the original adoption of the FY 2018-2019 budget.
49	
50	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY
51	COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:
52	
53	SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are confirmed as true and
54	incorporated herein.
55	
56	SECTION 2. Adoption of Budget Amendment. The Mayor and City
57	Commission hereby adopt the budget amendment to the FY 2018-2019 adopted budget
58	as set forth in Attachments A of this ordinance.
59 60	SECTION 3. Conflict. All ordinances, parts of ordinances, resolutions, or parts
61	of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed, to the extent of the conflict.
62	
63	SECTION 4. Severability. Should any provision of this Ordinance be declared by
64	a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of
65	this Ordinance as a whole or any portion thereof, other than the part that is declared to be
66	
67	invalid.

68	SECTION 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon
69	adoption.
