## RESOLUTION NO. 2019-

A RESOLUTION OF CHAIR AND BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE HALLANDALE BEACH COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE FUNDING FOR FLORIDA INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$160,000 FOR THE TASTE OF HALLANDALE FOOD FESTIVAL IN CONNECTION WITH THE SOUTH BEACH WINE AND FOOD FESTIVAL AND TWO MOVIE NIGHT EVENTS: AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR AND HBCRA ATTORNEY TO NEGOTIATE AND FINALIZE AN AGREEMENT WITH FLORIDA INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE TASTE OF HALLANDALE FOOD FESTIVAL IN CONNECTION WITH THE SOUTH BEACH WINE AND FOOD FESTIVAL AND TWO MOVIE NIGHT EVENTS IN AN AMOUNT NOT-TO-EXCEED \$160,000; AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT; AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO TAKE ALL ACTION NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT THE TERMS OF THE AGREEMENT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, the mission of the Hallandale Beach Community Redevelopment Agency ("HBCRA") is to promote economic development and enhance the quality of life by eliminating and preventing blighted conditions through the facilitation of community partnerships, business growth, job creation, and neighborhood rehabilitation; and

**WHEREAS**, the promotion of the Community Redevelopment Area and the use of tax increment funds therefore falls within the purposes of the Community Redevelopment Act set forth in Part III, Chapter 163, Florida Statues; and

WHEREAS, the procurement of the services of Florida International University in an amount not to exceed \$160,000 for the Taste of Hallandale Food Festival in connection with the South Beach Wine and Food Festival and two Movie Night events is permissible under Section 23-8(5) of the City of Hallandale Beach Procurement Code as a unique circumstances where the Board of Directors of the HBCRA finds unique circumstances to establish that competitive bidding is not in the best interest of the HBCRA; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the HBCRA desires to (a) approve the funding in an amount not to exceed \$160,000 to Florida International University for the Taste of Hallandale Food Festival in connection with the South Beach Wine and Food Festival and two Movie Night events, which event will, among others things, promote the Community Redevelopment Area, and (b) authorize the negotiation, finalization and execution of an agreement with Florida International University for the Taste of Hallandale Food Festival in connection with the South Beach Wine and Food Festival and two Movie Night events in an amount not-to-exceed \$160,000.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CHAIR AND BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE HALLANDALE BEACH COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY:

Section 1. Recitals. The recitals in the whereas clauses are true and correct, and incorporated into this Resolution.

Section 2. Waiver of Competitive Biding Due to Unique Circumstances. Pursuant to Section 23-8(5) of the City of Hallandale Beach Procurement Code the procurement of the services of Florida International University in an amount not to exceed \$160,000 for the Taste of Hallandale Food Festival in connection with the South Beach Wine and Food Festival and two Movie Night events is permissible as unique circumstances exist and the Board of Directors of the HBCRA finds that competitive bidding is not in the best interest of the HBCRA.

Section 3. <u>Approval of Funding.</u> The funding by the HBCRA in an amount not to exceed \$160,000 to Florida International University for the Taste of Hallandale Food Festival in connection with the South Beach Wine and Food Festival and two Movie Night events is hereby approved.

Section 4. Negotiation and Finalization of Agreement. The Executive Director and HBCRA Attorney are hereby authorized to negotiate and finalize an agreement with Florida International University for the Taste of Hallandale Food Festival in connection with the South Beach Wine and Food Festival and two Movie Night events or, provided the funds are used for the same purpose, its designee in an amount not-to-exceed \$160,000, which agreement will provide that (a) Florida International University is authorized to make payments directly to its vendors and (b) the Executive Director may be authorized to make direct payments to certain vendors, all in connection with the administration, production and execution of the Taste of Hallandale Food Festival and two Movie Night events.

Section 5. <u>Execution of Agreement</u>. The Executive Director is hereby authorized to execute the agreement with Florida International University for the Taste of Hallandale Food Festival in connection with the South Beach Wine and Food Festival and two Movie Night events in an amount not-to-exceed \$160,000.

Section 6. <u>Implementation of Agreement</u>. The Executive Director is hereby authorized to take all steps necessary and appropriate to implement the terms and conditions of the agreement.

Section 7. <u>Effective Date</u>. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval.
