4 5 7 8 9 10 11	A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING MEMBERSHIP IN THE FLORIDA RETIREMENT SYSTEM FOR GENERAL EMPLOYEES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
12	WHEREAS, the City of Hallandale Beach and Florida Public Employees Council #79 of
13	the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees (AFL-CIO), Local 2009
14	("AFSCME Local 2009"), which represents a bargaining unit of the City's general employees,
15	recently ratified a new collective bargaining agreement covering the period October 1, 2019
16	through September 30, 2022; and
17	WHEREAS, under the terms of the collective bargaining agreement, the City will join the
18	Florida Retirement System ("FRS") for general employees on January 1, 2020, or soon thereafter
19	as administratively feasible; and
20	WHEREAS, consistent with the collective bargaining agreement, the Mayor and City
21	Commission have determined that it is in the best interest of the City and all its general employees
22	to join the Florida Retirement System; and
23	WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission have determined that it is consistent with the
24	policy and purposes of the City to extend to the City's general employees, not excluded by law, the
25	benefits of the Florida Retirement System, on the basis of applicable State laws and amendments
26	thereto, and rules and regulations, and hereby authorize and direct the City Manager to execute
27	agreements thereto with the Florida Department of Management Services, for coverage of said
28	general employees under the Florida Retirement System; providing for withholding from salaries
29	and wages of general employees of the City of Hallandale Beach so covered to be made and paid
30	over as provided by applicable State laws or regulations; providing that the City shall appropriate
31	and pay over employer contributions and assessments as provided by applicable State laws or

32 regulations; and providing that the City shall keep records and make reports as required by

33 applicable State laws or regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, THAT: 36

SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are confirmed as true and incorporated 37 38 herein.

39

40 **SECTION 2.** It is hereby declared to be the policy and purpose of the City of Hallandale 41 Beach, Florida, that all its general employees except those excluded by law, shall participate in 42 the Florida Retirement System as authorized by Chapter 121, Florida Statutes. All current general 43 employees who elect to participate in the Florida Retirement System shall be members of the 44 Florida retirement System as of the effective date of the City's participation in the Florida 45 Retirement System, and all general employees hired by the City in the future shall be compulsory 46 members of the Florida Retirement System beginning on their date of employment.

47

48 **SECTION 3.** The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute all 49 necessary agreements and amendments thereto with the Administrator of the Florida Retirement 50 System for the purpose of extending the benefits provided by the Florida Retirement System to 51 the general employees of the City of Hallandale Beach, which agreement shall provide for such 52 methods of administration of the plan by said City of Hallandale Beach as are found by the 53 Administrator of the Florida Retirement System to be necessary and proper, and shall be effective 54 with respect to any employment covered by such agreement for serviced performed on and after 55 January 1, 2020.

56

57 SECTION 4. Withholding from salaries, wages, or other compensation of general 58 employees for the purposes provided in Section 2 hereof are hereby authorized to be made, and 59 shall be made, in the amounts and at such times as may be required by applicable State laws or 60 regulations, and shall be paid over to the Administrator designated by said laws or regulations to 61 receive such amounts.

62

63 **SECTION 5.** There shall be appropriated from available City funds, derived from City 64 general revenues, such amounts and at such times as may be required to pay promptly the 65 contributions and assessments required of the City, by applicable State laws or regulations, which

- shall be paid over to the lawfully designated Administrator of the Florida Retirement System at the 66 times and in the manner provided by law and regulation. 67
- 68

69 **SECTION 5.** The City shall keep such records and make such reports as may be required 70 by applicable State laws or regulations, and shall adhere to all laws and regulations relating to the 71 Florida Retirement System.

72

73 The City does hereby adopt the terms, conditions, requirements, SECTION 6. 74 reservations, benefits, privileges, and other conditions thereunto appertaining, of the Florida 75 Retirement System, for and on behalf of all general employees of its departments and agencies 76 to be covered under the agreement.

77

78 **SECTION 7.** The Finance Director of the City of Hallandale Beach is hereby designated 79 the custodian of all sums withheld from the compensation of general employees as authorized 80 herein and of the appropriated funds for the employer's contributions as provided in Section 5 81 hereof. The Finance Director is further designated the withholding and reporting agent and 82 charged with the duty of maintaining records for the purpose of implementing this Resolution. 83

84 **SECTION 8.** A copy of this Resolution fully executed as in original, duly attested by the 85 City Clerk, shall be furnished to the Administrator of the Florida Retirement System.
