16 17	WHEREAS, saltwater intrusion into the Biscayne Aquifer has made it increasingly
18	apparent that the City must seek alternative water supply sources; and
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20	WHEREAS, in 2011, the City received a grant to implement a reuse water program
21	utilizing reuse water from the City of Hollywood; and
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23	WHEREAS, Miller Legg completed a feasibility study for the reuse program in March 2013,
24	which the City expanded in March 2015 by utilizing EAC Consulting to include engineering,
25	permitting, and limited post design services; and
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27	WHEREAS, the City issued an Invitation to Bid in February of 2016, but the City
28	Commission rejected the lone response it received due to the respondent's lack of experience
29	and subsequently authorized a re-bid of the project; and
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31	WHEREAS, on May 6, 2016, the City Administration reissued the Invitation to Bid and
32	held a non-mandatory pre-bid conference. The City received two (2) responses to the solicitation;

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35	WHEREAS, the City Administration reviewed each response and concluded that Close
36	Construction, LLC, was the lowest, responsible, responsive bidder; and
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39	WHEREAS, pursuant to code section 23-4, all purchases of goods and services above
40	fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) shall be subject to competitive bidding. Section 23-6 authorizes
41	the City Manager to recommend the award of a contracts to the City Commission; and
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43	WHEREAS, the City Administration recommends that the Mayor and the City Commission
44	award the Rebid RFP #2015-2016-009-001 to Close Construction, LLC in an amount not to
45	exceed one million three hundred ninety nine thousand eight hundred and eighty dollars
46	(\$1,339,880.00), authorize the City Manager to execute an agreement with Close Construction,
47	LLC, as well as authorize a ten percent (10%) contingency for unforeseen circumstances; and
