| 20 | in South Florida and with a population that is rising, coupled with the limitations of the Biscayne |

| 24 | study identified installing an eight inch PVC reuse water line from the City of Hollywood, Wiley |

| 27 | WHEREAS, the proposed installation of the eight inch reuse water line will provide for the |
| 28 | irrigation of Joe Scavo Park, thereby affording the City with the capacity for up to 0.25 MGD of |
