| 48 | (b) Members. The board shall consist of five (5) voting members appointed at-large by         |
| 49 | the City Commission. The five (5) members shall be comprised of at least three (3)            |
| 50 | professionals employed in a Finance Related industry by an entity with an active              |
| 51 | Hallandale Beach business tax receipt and the remaining two (2) members shall be              |
| 52 | residents of the City of Hallandale Beach.  |

| 54 | (c) Power and duties. In addition to those responsibilities required of all advisory boards   |
| 55 | and committees, the Budget Oversight Board shall provide recommendations to the               |
| 56 | City Commission for each budget development cycle on an annual basis and shall                |
| 57 | meet quarterly at the following interval stages and perform the following:                    |
| 58 | 1. Budget Development Stage   |
| 59 | i. Assist with gaining citizen feedback   |
| 60 | ii. Prioritizing citizen requests/concerns  |
| 61 | iii. Support City Commission Strategy (updates)   |
| 62 | 2. Budget Approval Stage  |
| 63 | i. Examine and analyze the budget   |
| 64 | ii. Attend City Commission Meetings and provide feedback to the City                          |

| 66 | 3. Monitoring Stage   |
| 67 | i. Review approved expenditures   |

| 80        | <b>SECTION 4.</b> Severability. Should any provision of this ordinance be declared by a court         |

| 84        | SECTION 4. Codification. It is intent of the Mayor and City Commission that the                       |
| 85        | provisions of this ordinance be incorporated into the Code of Ordinances; to effect such intention    |
