A RESOLUTION OF CHAIR AND BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE HALLANDALE BEACH COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE FUNDING FOR SERVICE CORPS OF RETIRED EXECUTIVES ASSOCIATION INC. D/B/A SCORE BROWARD CHAPTER 17 IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$24,000 FOR THE PROVISION TOOLS. GUIDANCE AND SUPPORT TO LOCAL ENTREPRENEURS TO CONVERT IDEAS INTO COHESIVE AND SUCCESSFUL BUSINESSES IN ADDITION TO ASSISTING **EXISTING BUSINESSES EXPAND AND GROW; AUTHORIZING** THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR AND HBCRA ATTORNEY TO NEGOTIATE AND FINALIZE AN AGREEMENT WITH SERVICE CORPS OF RETIRED EXECUTIVES ASSOCIATION INC. D/B/A SCORE BROWARD CHAPTER 17 IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO **EXCEED \$24,000; AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR** EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT; AUTHORIZING THE **EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO TAKE ALL ACTION NECESSARY** TO IMPLEMENT THE TERMS OF THE AGREEMENT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the mission of the Hallandale Beach Community Redevelopment Agency ("HBCRA") is to promote economic development and enhance the quality of life by eliminating and preventing blighted conditions through the facilitation of community partnerships, business growth, job creation, and neighborhood rehabilitation; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the HBCRA desires to promote various community capacity building initiatives (for individuals as well as entrepreneurs) within the Community Redevelopment Area to facilitate social equity, which goal is not only to provide residents with the ability to participate in the economic development, and redevelopment efforts that the HBCRA is now undertaking, but to also increase opportunities for success; and

WHEREAS, these significant economic development and community capacity building efforts will operate under the Hallandale Beach BEACON program, which is an acronym for Business Engagement and Community Opportunity Now; and

WHEREAS, the procurement of the services of Service Corps of Retired Executives Association Inc. d/b/a Score Broward Chapter 17 in an amount not to exceed \$24,000 for the provision of proven tools, guidance and support to local entrepreneurs to convert ideas into cohesive and successful businesses in addition to assisting existing businesses expand and grow is permissible under Section 23-8(5) of the City of Hallandale Beach Procurement Code as a unique circumstances where the Board of Directors of the HBCRA finds unique circumstances to establish that competitive bidding is not in the best interest of the HBCRA; and

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WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the HBCRA desires to (a) approve the funding in an amount not to exceed \$24,000 to SCORE for the provision of proven tools, guidance and support to local entrepreneurs to convert ideas into cohesive and successful businesses in addition to assisting existing businesses expand and grow which will, among others things, lead, over time, to reduced gentrification, and continue the elimination of slum and blighted conditions, and (b) authorize the negotiation, finalization and execution of an agreement with SCORE in an amount not-to-exceed \$24,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CHAIR AND BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE HALLANDALE BEACH COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY:

- Section 1. Recitals. The recitals in the whereas clauses are true and correct, and incorporated into this Resolution.
- Section 2. Waiver of Competitive Bidding Due to Unique Circumstances. Pursuant to Section 23-8(5) of the City of Hallandale Beach Procurement Code the procurement of the services of SCORE in an amount not-to-exceed \$24,000 for the provision of proven tools, guidance and support to local entrepreneurs to convert ideas into cohesive and successful businesses in addition to assisting existing businesses expand and grow is permissible as unique circumstances exist and the Board of Directors of the HBCRA finds that competitive bidding is not in the best interest of the HBCRA.
- Section 3. <u>Approval of Funding.</u> The funding by the HBCRA in an amount not to exceed in an amount not-to-exceed \$24,000 to SCORE for the provision of proven tools, guidance and support to local entrepreneurs to convert ideas into cohesive and successful businesses in addition to assisting existing businesses expand and grow is hereby approved.
- Section 4. <u>Negotiation and Finalization of Agreement</u>. The Executive Director and HBCRA Attorney are hereby authorized to negotiate and finalize an agreement with SCORE for the provision of proven tools, guidance and support to local entrepreneurs to convert ideas into cohesive and successful businesses in addition to assisting existing businesses expand and grow in an amount not-to-exceed \$24,000.
- Section 5. <u>Execution of Agreement</u>. The Executive Director is hereby authorized to execute the agreement with SCORE in an amount not-to-exceed \$24,000.
- Section 6. <u>Implementation of Agreement</u>. The Executive Director is hereby authorized to take all steps necessary and appropriate to implement the terms and conditions of the agreement.
 - Section 7. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval.
