4	A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE
5	CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING PRESIDENT
6 7	DONALD J. TRUMP'S EXECUTIVE ORDER COMBATING THE RISE OF ANTI-SEMITISM AND ANTI-SEMITIC INCIDENTS IN THE UNITED
8	STATES AND AROUND THE WORLD WHICH AIMS TO PROTECT THE
9 10	APPROXIMATELY 2,900 JEWISH HOUSEHOLDS, AND THE APPROXIMATELY 900 EASILY IDENTIFIABLE MEMBERS OF THE
10	ORTHODOX JEWISH COMMUNITY LIVING IN HALLANDALE BEACH
12	AND SUSCEPTIBLE TO ANTI-SEMITIC ATTACKS; DIRECTING THE
13 14	CITY CLERK TO DISTRIBUTE AS APPROPRIATE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
15	
16	WHEREAS, anti-Semitic incidents and speech are becoming more blatant and
17	pronounced, with the latest face of anti-Semitism being the anti-Jewish and anti-Israel
18	Boycott, Divestment and Sanctions (BDS) movement. BDS is NOT a peaceful movement
19	but is a cover up for anti-Semitic attacks on Jews in the United States, Israel and around
20	the World, with the ultimate goal being the elimination of Jews, especially the 6,000,000
21	Jews living in Israel; and

23	WHEREAS, President Donald J. Trump's executive order states: Title VI of the
24	Civil Rights Act of 1964 (Title VI), 42 U.S.C. 2000d et seq., prohibits discrimination on the
25	basis of race, color, and national origin in programs and activities receiving Federal
26	financial assistance, and since Title VI does not cover discrimination based on religion, It
27	shall be the policy of the executive branch to enforce Title VI against prohibited forms of
28	discrimination rooted in anti-Semitism as vigorously as against all other forms of
29	discrimination prohibited by Title VI; and
30	
31	WHEREAS, the United States Department of Justice defines Hate Crimes as
32	having a devastating effect beyond the harm inflicted on any victim. They reverberate
33	through families, communities, and the entire nation, as others fear that they too could be
34	threatened, attacked, or forced from their homes, because of what they look like, who they
35	are, where they worship, whom they love, or whether they have a disability; and
36	
37	WHEREAS, our Country faces increased violent and murderous incidents of anti-

38 Semitic attacks against Jews; The City of Hallandale Beach recognizes the approximately

2,900 Jewish households, and our approximately 900 easily identifiable and susceptible
to anti-Semitic attacks members of the Orthodox Jewish community living in Hallandale
Beach; and

43 WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission have zero tolerance for anti-Semitism 44 and hate speech within city limits against our Jewish residents and hereby commit to 45 standing firmly with members of the Jewish community against any such acts. The Mayor 46 and City of Hallandale Beach commissioners hereby demand that State and Federal prosecuting agencies aggressively prosecute Hate Crimes as defined by the Department 47 48 of Justice like those protected by Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.and will request 49 any and all State and Federal Funding available to assist in fighting and combating anti-50 Semitism and hate crimes.

52 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY 53 COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are incorporated herein.

57 SECTION 2. Aware of the increased violent and murderous incidents of anti-58 Semitic attacks against Jews, the Mayor and City Commission hereby denounce verbal 59 and physical attacks on the Jewish community and support President Trump's executive 60 order to enforce Title VI against prohibited forms of discrimination rooted in anti-Semitism as vigorously as against all other forms of discrimination prohibited by Title VI. Further, the 61 62 Mayor and City of Hallandale Beach commissioners hereby demand that State and 63 Federal prosecuting agencies aggressively prosecute Hate Crimes as defined by the 64 Department of Justice like those protected by Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.and 65 will request any and all State and Federal Funding available to assist in fighting and 66 combating anti-Semitism and hate crimes.
