RESOLUTION NO. 2020-

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF
THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING
CONTRACTING WITH SOUTH FLORIDA REGIONAL PLANNING
COUNCIL TO PREPARE A POST-DISASTER REDEVELOPMENT
PLAN IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED FOURTY THOUSAND
(\$40,000) DOLLARS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE
DATE.**

WHEREAS, the City's Coastal Management Element of the City's Comprehensive Plan Policy 3.2.3 states:

The City shall prepare Post-Disaster Redevelopment Plans for the CHHA that identify strategies to reduce or eliminate the exposure of human life, public property, and private property to natural hazards by 2020., and

WHEREAS, the City was awarded a grant by the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity (FDEO) providing \$40,000 of funding to prepare a Post-Disaster Redevelopment Plan (PDRP); and

WHEREAS, PDRPs are intended to be used as a guide to redeveloping a community after a major or catastrophic disaster. PDRPs are intended to reduce a community's vulnerability to disaster in the long-term and allow for faster, more thoughtful, and efficient recovery in the aftermath; and

WHEREAS, City administration recommends entering into a contract with South Florida Regional Planning Council (SFRPC), a government entity, under Section 23-8 (2) and (5) of our Procurement Code to conduct the PDRP to ensure the City meets the grant funding deadlines for deliverables. The City will utilize grant funds provided for this purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. City Manager Authorization. The Mayor and City Commission hereby authorize the City Manager to enter into an agreement with the South Florida Regional Planning Council to conduct the PDRP in an amount not to exceed forty thousand (\$40,000) dollars.

SECTION 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
