21	Opportunity (FDEO) providing \$40,000 of funding to prepare a Post-Disaster Redevelopment Plan		
22	(PDRP); and

24	WHEREAS, PDRPs are intended to be used as a guide to redeveloping a community after		
25	a major or catastrophic disaster. PDRPs are intended to reduce a community's vulnerability to		
26	disaster in the long-term and allow for faster, more thoughtful, and efficient recovery in the		
27	aftermath; and

29	WHEREAS, City administration recommends entering into a contract with South Florida		
30			
31	Procurement Code to conduct the PDRP to ensure the City meets the grant funding deadlines for		
32 33	deliverables. The City will utilize grant funds provided for this purpose.
