4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11 12 13	A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT WITH PALM BEACH AGGREGATES, LLC TO EXTEND CERTAIN MILESTONE DATES SPECIFIED IN THE ORIGINAL AGREEMENT FOR THE CAPACITY ALLOCATION OF ONE MILLION GALLONS OF WATER PER DAY FROM PHASE 1 OF THE C-51 RESERVOIR; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
14	WHEREAS, the City of Hallandale Beach has endeavored to protect the City's Biscayne
15	Aquifer water supply since the initial drilling of water supply wells in the City. As a coastal
16	community, the movement of the saltwater front into the Biscayne Aquifer is a constant and
17	continuing threat to the City's water supply; and
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19	WHEREAS, Palm Beach Aggregates will be constructing a series of interconnected
20	reservoirs (collectively, the "C-51 Reservoir") capable of receiving and storing water from areas
21	under the jurisdiction of the SFWMD in South Florida ("Region"), and discharging that water back
22 23	to the Region as an alternative water supply; and,
24	WHEREAS, the C-51 Reservoir will be constructed in two phases. Phase 1 of the C-51
25	Reservoir will consist of a reservoir with 14,000 acre-feet of storage capacity and appurtenant
26	facilities and works (the "Phase 1 Reservoir"). The Second Phase, if developed, will consist of an
27	anticipated additional 46,000 acre-feet of reservoir storage capacity and appurtenant facilities and
28	works (the "Phase 2 Reservoir"); and
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30	WHEREAS, on June 20, 2018 the City Commission, in Resolution 2018-055, authorized
31	the city to enter into an agreement with Palm Beach Aggregates for an apportionment of the water
32	supply from the C-51 Reservoir; and
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34	WHEREAS, on August 7, 2019, the City Commission, in Resolution 2019-061, authorized
35	the city to enter into a first amendment to extend certain milestone dates set forth in section 3.2.1
36	and section 11.1.2; and
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- WHEREAS, Palm Beach Aggregates, LLC is requesting a second amendment to sections
 3.2.1 and 11.1.2 as amended via Resolution 2019-061 as follows:
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- Section 11.1.2 Company's securing <u>full</u> Construction Financing for the Phase 1 Reservoir on or before <u>November 30, 2019 May 31, 2020</u>, with a closing date within ninety (90) days thereafter (the "Phase 1 Construction Finance Date"). On or before the tenth (10th) day after the Phase 1 Construction Finance Date, and at least sixty (60) days before the closing date for Construction Financing, Company shall notify Participant in writing of the Phase 1 Construction Finance Date, as well as the anticipated closing date for Construction Financing.
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53 WHEREAS, City Administration recommends that the City Commission authorize the City 54 Manager and City Attorney to negotiate and approve the Second Amendment to Agreement for 55 Capacity Allocation with Palm Beach Aggregates, LLC to extend certain milestone dates 56 approved via Resolution 2019-061 to the original Agreement for the allocation of one million 57 gallons a day of raw water from Phase 1 of the C-51 Reservoir; and

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59 **WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Commission have determined that the City 60 Administration's recommendations are in the best interest of the City and its residents.

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62NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY63COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:
