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14	WHEREAS, under the Florida Constitution and Section 166.021, Florida Statues,
15	municipalities are given broad home rule powers; and
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17	WHEREAS, as part of their home rule powers, municipalities should have the
18	ability to regulate vacation rentals in their jurisdiction; and
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20	WHEREAS, municipalities should continue to have the power to decide what is
21	consistent with the needs of their own communities; and
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23	WHEREAS, if Senate Bill 1128/House Bill 1011 passed, it would violate the home
24	rule powers of municipalities; and
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26	WHEREAS, the City Commission opposes Senate Bill 1128 and House Bill 1011;
