13	WHEREAS, the communication services tax is a vital source of revenue for cities		
14	including funding police, fire and other important municipal services; and

16	WHEREAS, is passed Senate Bill 1174 would reduce local revenues by \$19		
17	million statewide and result in a 25-35% reduction for the City of Hallandale Beach; and		
18			
19	WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1174, if passed, would significantly reduce such revenues		
20	that municipalities rely upon, placing a greater burden on other revenue sources		
21	including, ad valorem property taxes; and

23	WHEREAS, the City Commission opposes Senate Bill 1174; and

25	WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission believe it is in the best interest of the		
26	City to approve this Resolution; and
