RESOLUTION NO. 2020-

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, OPPOSING THE TERMINATION OF THE HAITIAN FAMILY REUNIFICATION PAROLE PROGRAM AND OTHER SIMILAR PAROLE PROGRAMS; PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF RECITALS; PROVIDING FOR INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CITY CLERK; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on January 25, 2017, President Donald Trump signed Executive Order No.: 13767: Border Security and Immigration Enforcement Improvements; and

WHEREAS, on August 2, 2019, U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services ("USCIS") announced its intention to terminate the Haitian Family reunification Parole Program ("HFRP Program") and the Filipino World War II Veterans Parole Program; and

WHEREAS, some policy makers, Congressional and State legislators strongly oppose the termination of the HFRP Program and other similar parole programs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hallandale Beach is approximately 20 percent Black or African American, 42 percent white, 36 percent Hispanic and 2 percent other; and

WHEREAS, the City embraces individuals of diverse backgrounds, including Haitian and other immigrant communities that have made the City their home; and

WHEREAS, the City also opposes the termination of the HFRP Program and other similar parole programs; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are incorporated herein.

36 **SECTION 2.** The Mayor and City Commission hereby oppose the termination of
37 the Haitian Family Reunification Parole Program and other similar parole programs and
38 encourage the government to reinstate the program.

40 **SECTION 3. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon
41 its passage and adoption.
