# **SHORT TITLE:**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA; CALLING FOR A GENERAL ELECTION ON NOVEMBER 3, 2020 TO ELECT THE SEATS OF MAYOR, COMMISSIONER SEAT #3 AND COMMISSIONER SEAT #4 TO THE CITY COMMISSION FOR A FOUR YEAR TERM; SETTING THE QUALIFYING PERIOD FOR COMMENCEMENT ON JUNE 8, 2020 AT 12:00 PM AND ENDING ON JUNE 12, 2020 AT 12:00 PM; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

# **STAFF SUMMARY:**

#### **Summary:**

Pursuant to the City's Charter, a General City Election for the purpose of electing members to the City Commission shall be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of each even-numbered year. Since the 2005 General City Election, each City Commission Seat (including Mayoral Seat) were elected for four-year terms that were staggered so that, alternately, two or three Commissioners are elected every two years.

The next Municipal General Election is scheduled for Tuesday, November 3, 2020 for the election of Three (3) seats: The Mayoral seat and Two (2) City Commission seats identified as seats 3 and seat 4 currently occupied by Mayor Joy F. Cooper (Mayor), Commissioner Anabelle Lima-Taub (Seat 3) and Commissioner Michele Lazarow (Seat 4).

#### **Background:**

Mayor Joy F. Cooper was elected to the Mayoral seat at the November 8, 2016 Municipal General Election for a Four (4) year term.

Commissioner Anabelle Lima-Taub was elected to Seat 3 at the November 8, 2016 Municipal General Election for a Four (4) year term.

Commissioner Michele Lazarow to Seat 4 at the November 8, 2016 Municipal General Election for a Four (4) year term.

#### **Current Situation:**

Currently, the term of the Mayoral Seat and Two (2) City Commission seats (Seats 3 & 4) will expire upon the November 3, 2020 Municipal General Election where the electorates of the City will elect a Mayor and Two City Commissioners for a Four (4) year term.

The attached proposed Ordinance would call the Municipal General Election for the four-year term election of the Mayoral Seat and Commission at-large Seat #3 and Seat #4 and setting the qualifying period for Monday, June 8, 2020 at 12:00 PM (noon) and ends on Friday, June 12, 2020 at 12:00 PM.

#### Why Action is Necessary:

Pursuant to Article III, Section 3.09(3) (c) When, at a regular city election in addition to regular commission offices, it becomes necessary to fill a commission vacancy or vacancies which have occurred under the provisions of section 3.09(1), candidates shall be elected according to the provisions of article IV of the Charter

Pursuant to Article IV, Section 4.01 of the City of Hallandale Beach Charter, the City Commission, by ordinance and subject to the provision of this Charter, shall have the power to call Regular and Special Elections as may be required by the City.

#### **Cost Benefit:**

A cost benefit exists by participating in the General Election as this allows for a reduced fiscal impact deriving from the City's proportionate share of the election cost and staff will budget this impact accordingly upon receipt of the initial estimated cost provided by the Supervisor of Elections as part of the FY 2020-2021 Budget.
