15	COVID-19 a pandemic; and

17	WHEREAS, Novel Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) is a severe acute		
18	respiratory illness that can spread among humans through respiratory transmission and		
19 20	other potential methods, and presents symptoms similar to those of influenza; and		
21	WHEREAS, on March 9, 2020, Governor DeSantis issued Executive Order		
22	Number 20-52 regarding COVID-19, declaring a state of emergency in the State of Florida,		
23	has issued Stay-at-home orders and ordered the closure of non-essential businesses and		
24	activities; and

26	WHEREAS, the City administration predicts significant shortages in anticipated		
27	revenues and has commenced cost-cutting measures while also incurring unanticipated		
28	costs relating to the pandemic; and		
29			
30	WHEREAS, for Fiscal Year 19-20, each member of the City Commission was		
31	allocated nine thousand (\$9,000) dollars for travel which, by commission policy is paid out		
32	to commissioners at the end of the fiscal year if unused. There is currently a remaining		
33	balance of thirty-six thousand four hundred and eighty-five (\$36,485) dollars; and

35	interest of the residents for the remaining funds to be reallocated to fund balance to help cover additional costs and revenue shortages as the city responds to the Covid-19 crisis.
