THE HALLANDALE BEACH COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING THE SENIOR RENTAL/UTILITY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM; ALLOCATING \$30,000 TO THE SENIOR RENTAL/UTILITY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM; AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO TAKE ALL STEPS NECESSARY AND APPROPRIATE TO IMPLEMENT THE SENIOR RENTAL/UTILITY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the mission of the Hallandale Beach Community Redevelopment Agency ("HBCRA") is to enhance the quality of life of its residents through its commitment to ensuring that safe, decent, and affordable homes are available to the residents of the City of Hallandale Beach living in the Community Redevelopment Area (CRA); and

WHEREAS, there is an affordable housing crisis in our country with affordable housing defined as a situation in which the cost of the monthly rents or monthly mortgage payments including taxes, insurance, and utilities does not exceed 35% of a household's adjusted gross monthly income; and

WHEREAS, according to the June 2015 "Recommended Methodology for Supply & Demand Analysis for Broward County's Affordable Housing Market", the City of Hallandale Beach has a deficiency of 2,683 very low-income affordable housing units, which includes rental and homeownership; and

WHEREAS, the Broward County Affordable Housing Assessment by Florida International University found that Broward County is one of the most unaffordable places to live in the U.S. and that the study further revealed that the increasing cost of affordable rental units is severely impacting families who are already living is cost-burdened households (53.9%); and

WHEREAS, the HBCRA is seeking to create a rental/utility assistance program to assist struggling individuals (62 years old and older), which program would help low-income families facing eviction or utility shut-off so that such families will have access to emergency financial assistance for paying rent and utility expenses; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Senior Rental/Utility Assistance Program would help to make housing affordable for low-income elderly, as well as increase their quality of life with the goal of the program is to financially assist the low-income elderly in the CRA who are faced with a crisis in paying for rent and utility (electric and water) expenses; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the HBCRA desires to establish the Senior Rental/Utility Assistance Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CHAIR AND BOARD OF DIRECTORS 39 40 OF THE HALLANDALE BEACH COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY: 41 Section 1. Recitals. The recitals in the whereas clauses are true and correct, and 42 incorporated into this Resolution. Section 2. <u>Establishment of the Senior Rental/Utility Assistance Program</u>. The Senior 43 Rental/Utility Assistance Program is hereby established. 44 45 Section 3. Allocation of Funds to the Senior Rental/Utility Assistance Program. The allocation of \$30,000 to the Senior Rental/Utility Assistance Program is hereby approved. 46 47 Implementation of the Senior Rental/Utility Assistance Program. The Executive Director is hereby authorized to take all steps necessary and appropriate to implement 48 the Senior Rental/Utility Assistance Program including the policies and application process set 49 forth in the Agenda Cover Memo, and the Executive Director is hereby authorized to appropriate 50 51 and expend all the Senior Rental/Utility Assistance Program related expenses that do not to 52 exceed the spending limits of the Executive Director so that funds can be provided to CRA residents as quickly as possible; expenditures which exceed the Executive Director's spending 53 limits shall be brought back before the Board of Directors of the HBCRA for approval. 54 55 Section 5. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval.
