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13	WHEREAS, the City of Hallandale Beach, Florida is densely populated with		
14	numerous condominium and homeowner associations; and		
15	WHEREAS, condominium associations are governed by Florida Statute 718 et.		
16	Seq., "The Florida Condominium Act" and homeowner associations are governed by		
17	Florida Statute 720 et. Seq. "The Florida Homeowner Association Act;" and		
18	WHEREAS, each year the Florida Legislature typically passes new laws and		
19	amends the foregoing statutes in order to better protect the residents of the State of		
20	Florida, including those that live within the City; and		
21	WHEREAS, as a result of several court decisions, many of the new laws that get		
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25	will be governed by the version of Chapter 718 or Chapter 720 that was in effect when the		
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27	WHEREAS, some associations have the "as amended from time to time" language		
28	in their governing documents and others do not. This has led to new laws being applicable		
29	to some associations in this city while at the same time not being applicable to those		
30	associations that do not have "as amended from time to time" language in their governing		
31	documents; and		
32	WHEREAS, as a result of the foregoing, each condominium and HOA in the City		
33	is governed by different sets of statutes, depending upon when the condominium or HOA		
34 25	was built, what statute was in effect at that time, and whether the governing documents		
35 26	contain "as amended from time to time" language, known as "Kaufman Language;" and		
36 27	WHEREAS, the foregoing has resulted in confusion and inconsistencies between		
37	the laws that apply to communities that are even located next to each other, as one		

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community may be subject to the laws as they existed before Florida Statutes 718 or 720
even existed, while the neighboring community which was built at exactly the same time
may be subject to the current version of these statutes; and

41 **WHEREAS,** in the interests of protecting the owners of condominium units and 42 homes located in homeowner associations, this commission recommends that all 43 community associations adopt amendments to their governing documents which 44 incorporates "as amended from time to time" language; and

WHEREAS, in the interests of protecting residents in condominiums and homeowner associations in the State of Florida, this Commission requests that the Florida Legislature enact legislation that requires all new declarations of condominium and declarations of covenants and restrictions to contain language that automatically incorporates legislative amendments as they are passed by the Florida Legislature from time to time.

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SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are incorporated herein.

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61 <u>SECTION 3.</u> The Mayor and City Commission hereby requests that the Florida 62 Legislature enact legislation that requires all new declarations of condominium and 63 declarations of covenants and restrictions to contain language that automatically 64 incorporates legislative amendments as they are passed by the Florida Legislature from 65 time to time.

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67 **SECTION 4.** The City Clerk is hereby instructed to distribute this resolution to 68 associations known to the City and to other individuals and representatives, as 69 appropriate, including City Clerks of other municipalities, the Florida League of Cities and 70 the Broward Delegation.
