December 03, 2018: Discovery is ongoing: The Court has set a Case Management Conference for August 30, 2019 which can be resolved by written agreement. The Issue: One (1) of several pumps specified for install, on the underlying project to upgrade the City's storm water management system, was declined by the City. The pump operates, but slightly under maximum intended capabilities. As a result, the City has refused to release all retainage owed on the project. The withheld retainage is a significant sum. TLC maintains that it ordered and installed the specified pump from the manufacturer, which is a very straight-forward process. Specified equipment failing to function at 100% in the designed environment is not a construction failure, but a design error. TLC objected to being held financially responsible for design error and attempted to negotiate with the City for approximately five (5) months prior to initiation of litigation. TLC also requested early mediation in the litigation.






