6 APPLICATIONS TO BROWARD COUNTY, SEEKING FUNDING
7 UNDER THE MOBILITY ADVANCEMENT PROGRAM (PENNY
8 FOR TRANSPORTATION) FOR THE REPAIR & MAINTENANCE
9 CROSSWALKS UPGRADES PROJECT HALL-003 (BC-
10 HBEACH-FY2020-00002), AND REPLACING EXISTING
11 DAMAGED SIDEWALKS PROJECT HALL-004 (BC-HBEACH-
12 FY2020-00001); AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO
13 EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS TO SUBMIT
14 APPLICATIONS AND IMPLEMENT IF AWARDED; AND
15 PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

17 **WHEREAS**, Broward County will provide funding from the Transportation Surtax revenues
18 for municipalities' Rehabilitation and Maintenance ("R&M") projects; and
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20 **WHEREAS**, Projects will be evaluated and ranked by Broward County and then vetted to
21 determine programmability in accordance with the Interlocal Agreement; and
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23 **WHEREAS**, a Resolution from the City of Hallandale Beach Mayor and City Commission
24 stating support for the projects submitted for Cycle 1 funding is required to establish eligibility;
25 and
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27 **WHEREAS**, the City is Hallandale Beach has submitted two (2) separate R&M Project
28 applications for funding through Broward County; and
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30 **WHEREAS**, the first application is an R&M Project for rehabilitating and providing textured
31 patterned on Crosswalks at intersections along Dixie Highway, Federal Highway, and Hallandale
32 Beach Boulevard in order to improve safety and security for pedestrians and bicyclists, as well as
33 to help create jobs and beautify and increase safety outside frontage of local businesses, with a
34 total budget amount requested of \$ 1,710,485.00; and
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36 **WHEREAS**, the second application is an R&M Project for replacing damaged sidewalks
37 (tripping hazards), and addressing ADA sidewalk deficiencies in order to improve safety and
38 security for pedestrians and bicyclists, as well as to help create jobs and beautify and increase

safety outside frontage of local businesses, with a total budget amount requested of \$ 2,971,710.00; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission find the two Projects to be in the public interest of the City of Hallandale Beach and hereby state their support for HALL-003 (BC-HBEACH-FY2020-00002) Crosswalks Upgrades Project, and HALL-004 (BC-HBEACH-FY2020-00001) Replacing Existing Damaged Sidewalks Project; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The foregoing “whereas” clauses are incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. Endorsement and Authorization. The Mayor and the City Commission of the City of Hallandale Beach, Florida, hereby state their support for applications seeking funding from Broward County Transportation Surtax revenue for HALL-003 (BC-HBEACH-FY2020-00002) Crosswalks Upgrades Project, and HALL-004 (BC-HBEACH-FY2020-00001) Replacing Existing Damaged Sidewalks. The City Manager is authorized to execute all necessary documents to submit applications and implement if awarded.

SECTION 3. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.
