### SHORT TITLE:

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, ENDORSING APPLICATIONS TO BROWARD COUNTY, SEEKING FUNDING UNDER THE MOBILITY ADVANCEMENT PROGRAM (PENNY FOR TRANSPORTATION) FOR THE REPAIR & MAINTENANCE CROSSWALKS UPGRADES PROJECT HALL-003 (BC-HBEACH-FY2020-00002), AND REPLACING EXISTING DAMAGED SIDEWALKS PROJECT HALL-004 (BC-HBEACH-FY2020-00001); AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS TO SUBMIT APPLICATIONS AND IMPLEMENT IF AWARDED; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

### STAFF SUMMARY:

#### **Background:**

In accordance with the First Amendment to Transportation System Surtax Interlocal Agreement (Exhibit 2), the County developed a prioritization process for municipal rehabilitation and maintenance projects that allows Municipalities to submit rehabilitation and maintenance projects

as part of the Transportation Surtax Plan. The County recently created an application portal for municipalities to submit rehabilitation and maintenance projects for surtax funding in Fiscal Year 2021 (Cycle 1). The City of Hallandale Beach submitted two (2) projects that will be evaluated and ranked by Broward County Transportation Surtax (Mobility Advancement Program), then vetted for funding recommendation by the County's Oversight Board. Following the County's Interlocal Agreement, the surtax projects will compel local business participation.

**Why Action is Necessary:**

Broward County requires a Resolution in support of the individual projects for funding recommendation.

**Analysis:**

The City submitted the following projects:

**Crosswalk improvements citywide- HALL-003.** The first application submitted is a project addressing Crosswalk improvements citywide. This project contains crosswalk rehabilitation in various intersections including but not limited to, Dixie Highway, Federal Highway, and Hallandale Beach Boulevard. The total project budget is estimated at \$ 1,710,485.00.

**Sidewalk improvements citywide- HALL-004.** The second application submitted is a project to repair, replace and construct existing damaged or missing sidewalks. It also addresses ADA deficiencies in various locations city-wide. The total project budget is estimated at \$ 2,971,710.00.

In addition to a Resolution of support, the following documents were required for the application submittals and attached in Exhibits 3 and 4: Scope and Project Location Boundaries, Budget, Schedule, Method for Contracting, Site pictures, GIS location Maps.

**Cost Benefit:**

The above listed projects were planned and budgeted to be fully funded by the amount sought from surtax revenue. Both sidewalk and crosswalk enhancements will improve mobility, connectivity, safety and security for vehicles, pedestrian, and cyclist circulation and resolve ADA deficiencies. Additionally, pursuing the projects listed above will secure funding for projects which support the mobility strategy of the City Commission.

**PROPOSED ACTION:**

Staff recommends the City Commission approve the proposed Resolution in support of application for surtax funding for the above listed projects.
