14	WHEREAS, on May 25, 2020, George Floyd, an unarmed 46-year-old black man		
15	was killed while being arrested by police in Minneapolis, Minnesota; and		
16	WHEREAS, Mr. Floyd allegedly died after being pinned down under a police		
17	officer's knee for at least nine minutes, while handcuffed, lying face down on the street		
18	and begging to breathe, as three other officers looked on; and		
19	WHEREAS, this apparently unprovoked and intentional act of violence represents		
20	a blatant disregard for the dignity and sanctity of human life; and		
21	WHEREAS, the actions of the four Minneapolis police officers do not represent the		
22	actions or reflect the values of the men and women that serve and protect their respective		
23	communities with the highest level of professionalism, but their actions do impact the		
24	relationships between those communities and their police departments; and		
25	WHEREAS, this act of intolerable violence and other similar acts of violence meted		
26	out to members of the black community that have occurred across this Country throughout		
27	its history are unpardonable. The killing of Mr. Floyd must serve as a wake-up call to every		
28	human being that recognizes life as both a gift and human right; and		
29	WHEREAS, racism, racial discrimination and ethnic conflict and violence are		
30	pervasive and persisting challenges for the Country and threaten human development		
31	because of the obstacles which they pose to the fulfillment to basic human rights to		
32	survival, security, development, and social participation; and		
33	WHEREAS, racism has been shown to have negative cognitive, behavioral,		
34	affective, and relational effects on both child and adult victims nationally and globally,		
35	historically and contemporarily; and

47		opportunities for all individuals.
48	c)	Condemn abuse of power and discretion by agents of the State.
49	d)	Affirms its commitment to the safety and well-being of all individuals.
50	e)	Invite the residents and businesses of the City to remove intolerance
51		and hatred and to promote a diverse and inclusive community that
52		rejects hatred, prejudice, discrimination, or bigotry.
53	f)	Denounce racism in all its forms, including systemic racism,
54		conscious and unconscious bias.
