A RESOLUTION OF CHAIR AND BOARD OF DIRECTORS THE **HALLANDALE BEACH COMMUNITY** REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY. HALLANDALE BEACH. FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO ISSUE A PURCHASE ORDER TO TESLA INC. FOR THE PURCHASE OF A 2020 TESLA MODEL Y MOTOR VEHICLE AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$54,290 AND A CHARGING STATION AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$2,000; AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO TAKE ALL ACTION NECESSARY TO PURCHASE THE 2020 TESLA MODEL Y MOTOR VEHICLE FROM TESLA INC. AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$54,290 AND A CHARGING STATION AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$2,000; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Hallandale Beach Community Redevelopment Agency ("HBCRA") desires to purchase a 2020 Tesla Model Y Motor Vehicle at a cost not to exceed \$54,290 (the "Motor Vehicle") and a charging station at a cost not to exceed \$2,000, which Motor Vehicle will serve the needs of the HBCRA staff as, among other things, the Motor Vehicle will haul supplies to and from HBCRA events; and

WHEREAS, although the HBCRA staff would typically utilize the Florida Sheriff's Association Cooperative Purchasing Program Bid Number FSA19-VEL27 (the "Purchasing Program") to purchase the Motor Vehicle, the Motor Vehicle is not included the Purchasing Program; and

WHEREAS, in order to purchase the Motor Vehicle, the HBCRA Staff has considered the purchase of a Ford Interceptor, which is included in the Purchasing Program, and an analysis was performed to demonstrate the true cost of ownership for the Ford Interceptor versus the Motor Vehicle: and

WHEREAS, based on the analysis set forth in the Agenda Cover Memo, the total true cost to own the Ford Interceptor is \$87,937 and the total true cost to own the Motor Vehicle is \$86,657 and, while this difference is de minimus, after five (5) years the value of the Ford Interceptor is \$13,160 and the value of the Motor Vehicle is \$36,273, which makes the purchase of the Motor Vehicle a better investment for the HBCRA than the Ford Interceptor; and

WHEREAS, the Motor Vehicle also is product that has a reduced negative effect or increased positive effect on human health and the environment when compared with competing motor vehicles that serve the same purpose and the proposed purchase is part of the HBCRA Sustainable Initiative; and

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39 WHEREAS, the HBCRA staff has worked with the Fleet Administrator to obtain the best 40 pricing for the Motor Vehicle as it is not included the Purchasing Program; and 41 WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the HBCRA desires to authorize the Executive Director to issue a purchase order to Tesla Inc. for the purchase of the Motor Vehicle at a cost 42 not to exceed \$54,290 and a charging station at a cost not to exceed \$2,000. 43 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CHAIR AND BOARD OF 44 DIRECTORS OF THE HALLANDALE BEACH COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY: 45 Section 1. Recitals. The recitals in the whereas clauses are true and correct, and 46 47 incorporated into this resolution. Section 2. Authority to Issue Purchase Order. The Executive Director is hereby 48 authorized to issue a purchase order to Tesla Inc. for the purchase of a 2020 Tesla Model Y 49 Motor Vehicle at a cost not to exceed \$54,290 and a charging station at a cost not to exceed 50 \$2.000. 51 Section 3. Implementation of Purchase Order. The Executive Director is hereby 52 authorized to take all action necessary to purchase the 2020 Tesla Model Y Motor Vehicle from 53 Tesla Inc. at a cost not to exceed \$54,290 and a charging station at a cost not to exceed 54 55 \$2,000. 56 Section 4. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval.
