16 17	WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 23, Section 23-8 Exception to Bid
18	Requirements, (5) Unique Circumstances, the City Commission may determine
19	that there are unique circumstances to establish that competitive bidding is not in
20	the best interest of the City; and

22	WHEREAS, on April 2012, Plant Moran's Government Technology Consulting
23	Team was engaged to provide professional consulting services to support the City's
24	effort in replacing its core business information systems with an integrated Enterprise
25	Resource Planning (ERP) system; and
26	WHEREAS, the City completed a thorough process of conducting City-wide
27	Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) system selection in preparation for replacement
28	of the City's current software systems used in Financial Management, Human
29	Resources/Payroll, Development Services, Public Works and Utilities & Engineering
30	departments; and
31	WHEREAS, in 2013 the City Commission awarded RFP#FY2011-2012-026 for
32	the Tyler Technologies Munis system to Tyler Technologies, Inc., a city enterprise
33	solution, for a term that expires on July 31, 2020; and

35	WHEREAS, City Administration does not recommend potential replacement of
36	the ERP system, a time consuming and expensive process that is unnecessary at this
37	time, and therefore it is impossible to competitively solicit for the continued ERP
38	service; and

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40	WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission have determined it is in the best	
41	interest of the residents to find that there are unique circumstances for waiving	
42	competitive solicitation requirements for the continued use of the current ERP software	
43	and to authorize the City Manager to obtain one-year extensions as necessary until	
44	the City determines to replace the ERP system; and

46	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF	
47	THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

49	SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are incorporated herein.	
50	SECTION 2. Declaration of Unique Circumstance. The Mayor and City	
51	Commission declare a Unique Circumstance pursuant to Chapter 23, Section 8 (5)	
52	of the City of Hallandale Beach Code of Ordinances due to unique availability of	
53	licensing for existing vendors and programs of the city ERP program and the need	
54	to avoid unnecessary replacement costs that would be required for competitive	
55	solicitation.

57	SECTION 3. The Mayor and City Commission hereby authorize a one-year	
58	extension to Tyler Technologies, Inc., for the Tyler Technologies Munis system in the	
59	amount not to exceed two hundred seventy-eight thousand two hundred and eighty	
60	seven dollars (\$278,287.00). Further authorizing the City Manager to negotiate and	
61	execute agreements with Tyler Technologies for one-year extensions in future years	
62	for the amounts budgeted until the City determines to replace the ERP system.

64	SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately	
65	upon its passage and adoption.
